

Fabric Cutting Tips for 3-color & 4-color, 6" finished Fractured Tumbler blocks:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut four of each 3" finished blocks in one pass through the cutter in 3-color or 4-color designs. Combine four 3" blocks to make a 6" finished block.




3-Color Block – Shapes A


- Fabric Color 1 (Light Blue): Cut two 4½" x 4¼" rectangles. Place right side up over shapes A to cut four shapes.
- Fabric Colors 2 & 3 (Dark Blue & Green): Cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes A to cut two shapes.



4-Color Block – Shapes B

• Fabric Colors 1-4 (4 layers total): Cut one 4¾" square. Place right side up over shapes B to cut four shapes.









How to Sew the 3-color, 6" finished Fractured Tumbler Block: Press seams open unless otherwise directed in pattern.



Sew dark A piece to light A piece as shown. Make 2 A/A quarter units. Sew medium tone A piece to light A piece as shown. Make 2 A/A quarter units.




Position quarter units as shown. Sew quarter units into rows, then sew rows together to complete block.

Block should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".


How to Sew the 4-color, 6" finished Fractured Tumbler Block: Press seams open unless otherwise directed in pattern.



Sew two contrasting colors of B pieces as shown. Make 4 B/B units.


Sew two different contrasting colors of B pieces as shown. Make 4 B/B units.

Step 2




Sew one of each constrasting units together as shown. Make 4 B/B/B/B units.

Step 3



Position quarter units as shown. Sew into rows, then sew rows together to complete block.

Step 4



Block should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".


