Dies Needed:

GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block (55775)

- GO! Square-3-1/2" (3" Finished) (Shape 1)
- GO! Square-2" (1-1/2" Finished) (Shape 2)

GO! Qube 6" Companion Set-Angles (55788)

- GO! Triangles in Square-Sides-3" Finished Square (Shape 14)
- GO! Kite-Center-3" Finished Square (Shape 15)

GO! Qube Mix & Match 12" Block (55778)

- GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (Shape 1)

GO! Qube 12" Companion Set-Angles (55791)

- GO! Triangles in Square-Sides-6" Finished Square (Shape 14)
- GO! Kite-Center-6" Finished Square (Shape 15)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1-1/2 Finished) (55025)
- GO! Strip Cutter-3" (2-1/2 Finished) (55084)

Backing & Binding	7-5/8 yards

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Black	GO! Qube 6" Companion Set-Angles: Triangles in Square-Sides (Shape 14)	<p>Cut 144 Triangle in Square Side Pairs (Shape 14)</p> <p>Cut 15- 3" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into Triangle in Square Sides (Shape 14). Each strip will yield 10 pairs - set aside remaining fabric to use for the smaller squares.</p>
Black	GO! Qube 12" Companion Set-Angles: Triangles in Square-Sides (Shape 14)	<p>Cut 72 Triangles in Square-Sides pairs (Shape 14 from the GO! Qube 12" Companion Set-Angles)</p> <p>Cut 12—4-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 7" widths. Each strip will yield 6 pairs - set aside remaining fabric to use for the larger squares.</p>
Black	GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block: GO! Square-3-1/2" (3" Finished) (Shape 1)	Cut 72 Squares (Shape 1) from the 6" Qube GO! Square-3-1/2" (3" Finished)
Black	GO! Qube Mix & Match 12" Block: GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished) (Shape 1)	Cut 9 Squares (Shape 1) from the GO! Qube Mix & Match 12" Block, GO! Square-6-1/2" (6" Finished)
Colors 1-9	GO! Qube 6" Companion Set-Angles: GO! Kite-Center (Shape 15)	<p>From each of the 9 colors, cut 20 Kites (Shape 15 from the GO! Qube 6" Companion Set Angles)</p> <p>Cut 2—4" x width of fabric (WOF) strips from each of the 9 colors. Fanfold into 4" widths. Each strip will yield 10 kite shapes.</p>
Colors 1-9	GO! Qube 12" Companion Set-Angles: GO! Kite-Center (Shape 15)	<p>From each of the 9 colors - Cut 8 Kites (Shape 15 from the GO! Qube 12" Companion Angles)</p> <p>Cut 2 – 7" x width of fabric (WOF) strips from each of the 9 colors. Fanfold into 7" widths. Each strip will yield 6 kite shapes, set aside remaining fabric to use for the smaller squares in the sashing.</p>
Black	GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1-1/2" Finished) (55025)	Cut 24 Strips 2" wide x 24-1/2" long



Black	GO! Strip Cutter-3" (2-1/2" Finished) (55084)	Cut 8 Strips 3" wide X WOF Seam together for the Borders.
Various Colors	GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block: GO! Square-2" (1-1/2" Finished) (Shape 2)	Cut 2 of 8 Various Colors, 2"x 2" Squares

Kite Units

NOTE: Directions will be for one 24" finished block. Make 9 blocks.

1. Sew one 3" finished triangle in square-sides (GO! Qube 6" Companion Angles 55791-Shape 14) to each side of color 3" finished kite center (GO! Qube 6" Companion Angles 55791-Shape 15) as shown. Press seams open.

Make 20 Small Kite Units.

2. Repeat set using one 6" finished triangle in square -sides GO! Qube 12" Companion Angles (55791 Shape 14) to each side of color 6" finished kite center GO! Qube 12" Companion Angles 55791 Shape 15) as shown. Press seams open.

Make 8 Large Kite Units.



Double Kite Units

3. Sew two completed kite units together to make a Double Kite Unit as shown in diagram. *Pay close attention to the direction of the points kite.*

Press seams open.

Make 4 Small Double Kite Units and 4 Large Double Kite Units.



Corner Units

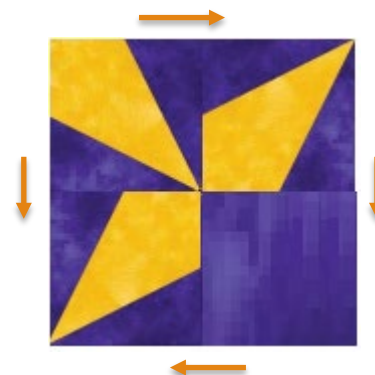
4. Sew two Small Kite Units made in Step 1. *Pay close attention to the direction of the points in the kite unit.*

Sew one Small Kite Unit made in Step 1 to one 3" finished solid black GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block (55775) Square – (Shape 1).

Pay close attention to the direction of the points in the kite unit

Pin and sew into 4 patch unit. Press seams as shown.

Make 4 Corner Units.



Center Section

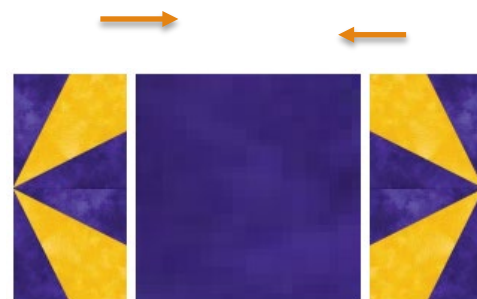
5. Pin and sew one 3" finished solid square (GO! Qube Mix and Match 6" Qube Shape 1-Square) to each side of the one Small Double Kite Unit that was created in Step 3.

Make 2 sets. *Pay close attention to the direction of the points in the Double Kite Unit. Press seams to outside*

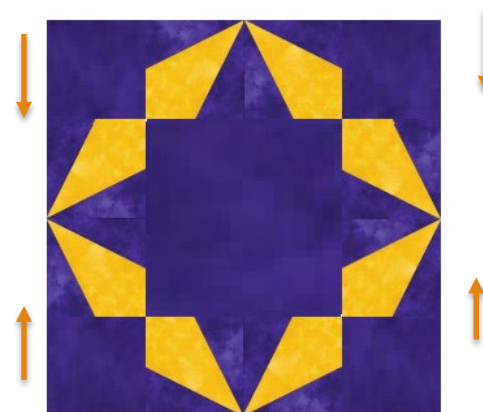


6. Pin and sew Double Kite Unit that was created in Step 3 to each side on one 6" finished solid black square (GO! Qube Mix & Match 12" Block (Shape 1)

Make 1 unit. *Pay close attention to the direction of the points in the Double Kite Unit. Press seams to the center*



7. Add one unit made in Step 5 to the top and one unit to the bottom, *Pay close attention to the direction of the points in the Double Kite Unit. Press seams to the inside as shown below.*



Assemble the Block

NOTE: Directions will be for one 24" finished block. Make 9 blocks.

Section A: Sew the 4-patch Corner Unit made in Step 4 to each side of the Large Double Kite Unit made in Step 1. *Pay close attention to the direction of the points in the kite unit*

Press seams to the outside

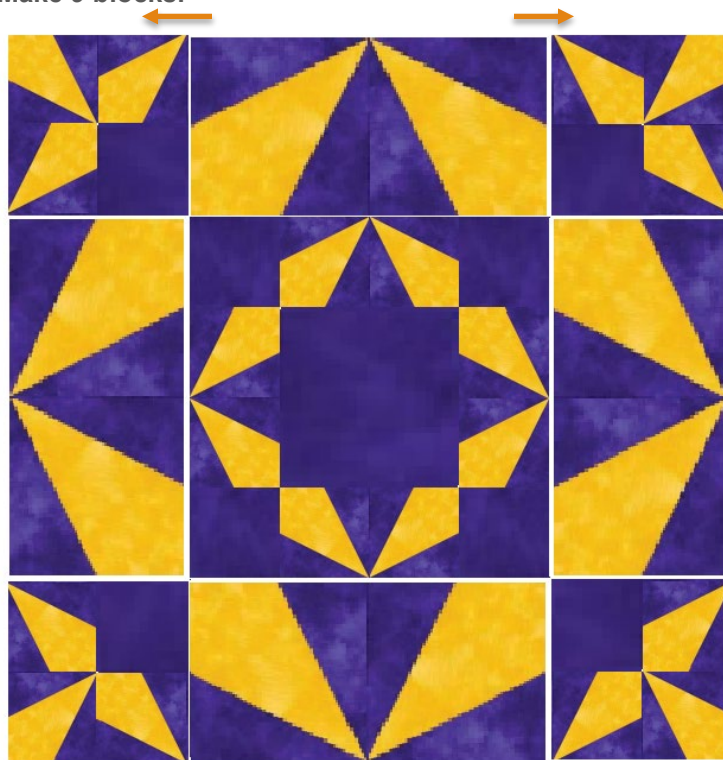
Section B: Sew one Large Double Kite Unit made in Step 1 to each side of the center unit. *Pay close attention to the direction of the points in the kite unit*

Press seams to the outside

Section C: Sew the 4-patch Corner Unit made in Step 4 to each side of the Large Double Kite Unit made in Step 1. *Pay close attention to the direction of the points in the kite unit*

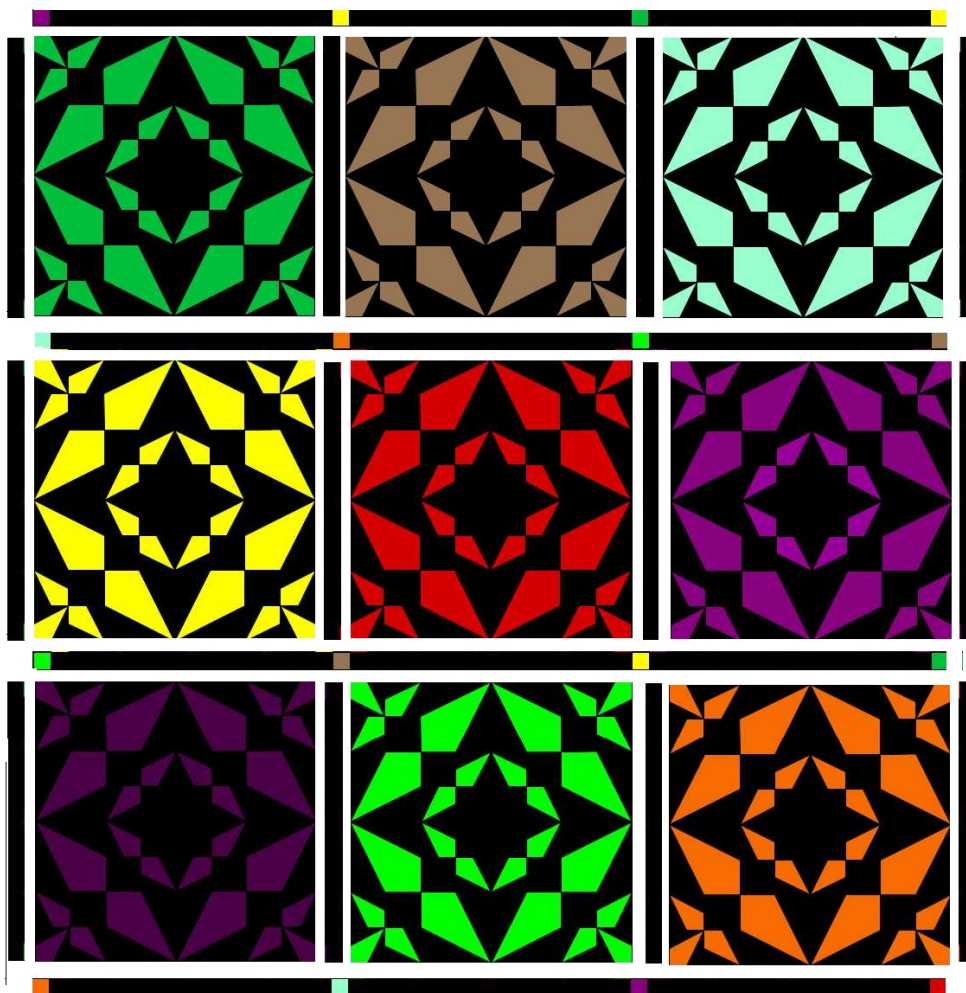
Press seams to the outside

Sew Section A to Section B press the seams up, then sew Section C press the seams.



Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in 3 rows of 3 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram.
2. Add sashing to each side of the blocks. Press seam inward.
3. Sew sashing and small squares between rows. Press seams inward.
4. Sew rows together.
5. Add boarder.



Quilting and Finishing

6. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
7. Pin or baste layers together.
8. Quilt as desired.
9. Add binding, mitring corners.
