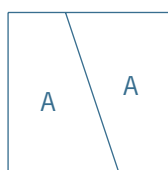


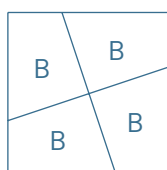
How to Cut & Sew FRACTURED TUMBLER BLOCKS:

Press seams toward darker fabric.

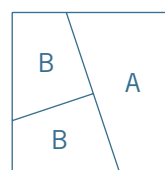
Make three tumbler block variations with one die.



Block option 1



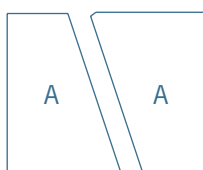
Block option 2

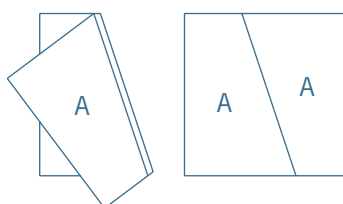
BLOCK OPTION 1

Step 1



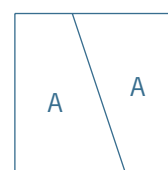
Use 2—A pieces.

Step 2

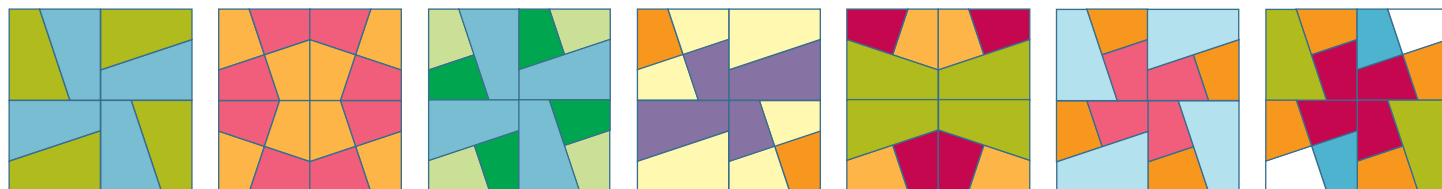


Sew 2—A pieces together.

Block should measure
6½" x 6½".



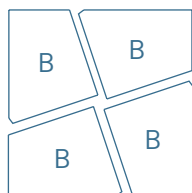
Tip: Play with different fabric and block combinations for endless quilt designs.

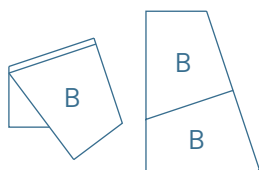
BLOCK OPTION 2

Step 1



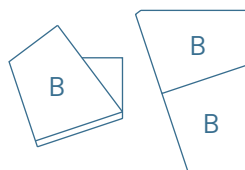
Use 4—B pieces.

Step 2



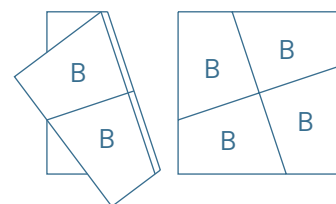
Sew 2—B pieces together.

Sew 2—B pieces together.

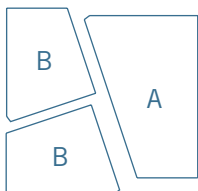
Step 4

6½" x 6½".

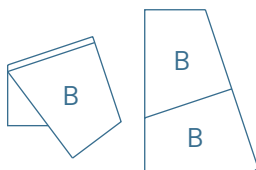
BLOCK OPTION 3

Step 1



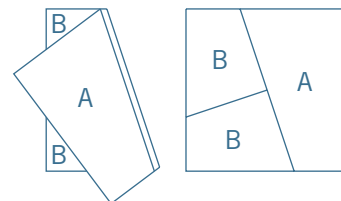
Use 1—A and 2—B pieces.

Sew 2—B pieces together.

Step 3



Sew piece B/B to A.

6½" x 6½".
