## Dies Needed:

- GO! Square-1½" (1" Finished) (55470)
- GO! Qube™ Mix & Match 8" Block (55776)
  - GO! Square-2½" (2" Finished) (Shape 2)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

## Cutting Directions:

White	2	Cut 2—5½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Sub cut into 36—2" finished squares.	1/2 yard
White	GO! Square-1½" (1" Finished) (55470)	Cut 1—5" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 72—1" finished squares.	Yardage included above

Green	<div>2</div>	Cut 1—5½" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Sub cut into 12—2" finished squares.	1/2 yard
Green	GO! Square-1½" (1" Finished) (55470)	Cut 1—5" x 15" strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 24—1" finished squares.	Yardage included above
Orange	<div>2</div>	Cut 1—5½" x 5½" square. Sub cut into 4—2" finished squares.	1/2 yard
Orange	GO! Square-1½" (1" Finished) (55470)	Cut 1—5" square. Sub cut into 8—1" finished square.	1/2 yard

### Additional Cutting Instructions:

- Black—Yardage included above
  - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 3—2½" x WOF strips for binding.
- Green—Yardage included above
  - Rotary cut 12½" x 26" rectangle for pillow back
- Orange—Yardage included above
  - Rotary cut 18½" x 26" rectangle for pillow back

### Additional Fabrics Needed:







- Batting: 26" x 26"
- Backing of Pillow Front: 26" x 26"
- Pillow Back: 3/4 yard if not using leftover green & orange from yardage listed
- Pillow Form: 1—24" pillow form

## Sewing Directions:

*Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

### Double 4-Patch Block

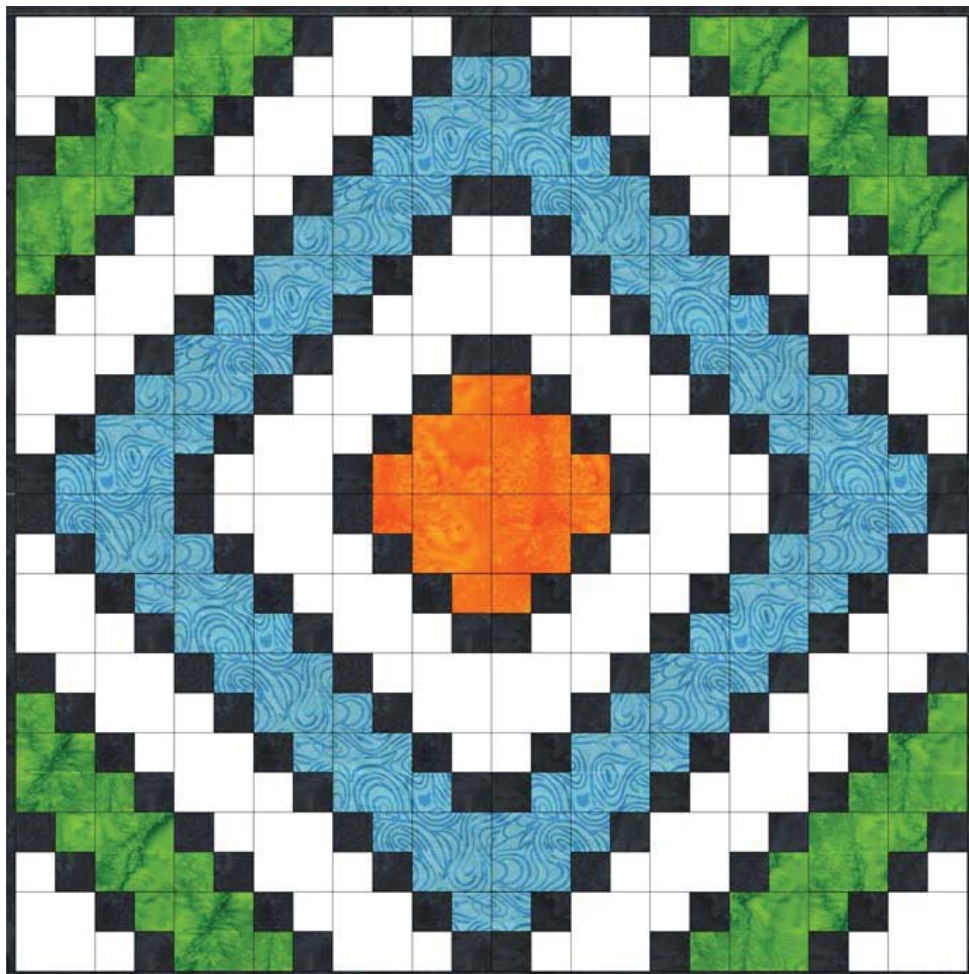
**NOTE:** The directions are given for 1 block. Repeat steps to make 20—blue blocks, 12—green blocks and 4—orange blocks.

1. Pin and sew one white and one black 1" finished square together as shown. Press seam towards the black square. Make 2 white/black square units.
 
2. Pin and sew one green and one black 1" finished square together as shown. Press seam toward the black square. Make 2 green/black square units.
 
3. Pin and sew one white/black square unit to one green/black square unit as shown. Be sure to sew as shown to get the proper block results. Press seams by swirling the center. Make 2—4-patch units.
 
4. Pin and sew one white 2" finished square to the small 4-patch as shown. Press seam towards the white square. Make one unit. Pin and sew one green 2" finished square to the small 4-patch as shown. Press seam towards the green square. Make one unit.
 

5. Pin and sew white/4-patch unit to green/4-patch unit as shown. Press seam by swirling center. Make 1—4" finished block.
 
6. Repeat steps 1 through 5 to make above noted number of blocks: 20—blue blocks, 12—green blocks and 4—orange blocks.



## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Lay out blocks 6 across by 6 down following diagram and rotating for correct color placement.
2. Pin and sew blocks together. Nest all seams to form 6 rows. Press rows 1, 3 and 5 to the left. Press rows 2, 4 and 6 to the right.
3. Pin and sew rows together. Nest all seams. Press seams to one side.

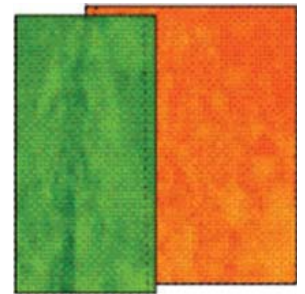
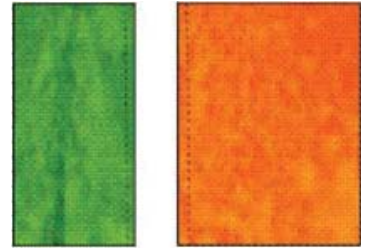


## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.

## Pillow Assembly

1. Press a double fold  $\frac{1}{2}$ " hem along one 26" length of green  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26" rectangle and orange  $18\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26" rectangle.
2. Stitch along 26" length to secure hem.
3. Overlap green over orange to make a 26" x 26" square. Baste overlap to secure.
4. Layer pillow top and pillow back wrong sides together and pin.
5. Baste around pillow top perimeter to secure.
6. Attach double fold binding to pillow top.
7. Trim pillow top and pillow back to  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $24\frac{1}{2}$ ".
8. Fold double fold binding to back and secure.
9. Insert pillow form and enjoy!



## GO! Elephant Carousel Quilt

Finished Size: 36" x 36"









### Dies Needed:

- GO! Elephants (55373)
- GO! Qube™ Mix & Match 8" Block (55776)
  - GO! Square-4½" (4" Finished) (Shape 1)
  - GO! Half Square Triangle-4" Finished Square (Shape 3)
  - GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square (Shape 5)
  - GO! Rectangle-2½" x 4½" (2" x 4" Finished) (Shape 8)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)



## Cutting Directions:

*\*NOTE: Apply fusible web to the wrong side of asterisked fabrics following manufacturer's instructions before cutting appliqué shapes.*

*Assorted Fabrics	GO! Elephants (55373)	Cut 5—2½" square scraps. Place up to 4 layers of fabric wrong side up over the large elephant. Sub cut into 5—large ears.	Scraps
*Assorted Fabrics	GO! Elephants (55373)	Cut 4—1½" square scraps. Place 4 layers of scraps wrong side up over the small ear. Sub cut into 4—small ears.	Scraps



## Additional Cutting Instructions:

- Purple
  - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 4—2½" x WOF strips for borders. Border strips are not pieced so one strip is used for each border (vertical and horizontal).
  - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 4—2½" x WOF strips for binding.

## Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Fusible Web: scraps
- Batting: 44" x 44"
- Backing: 1¼ yards

## Sewing Directions:

*Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

## Large Elephant Block

**NOTE: Make 5 Blocks.**

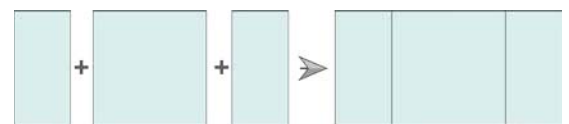
1. Sew one purple and one white 2" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 20 HST units.



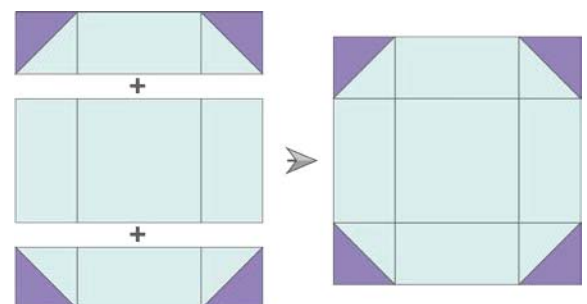
2. Sew one HST unit to each short end of a white rectangle (Shape 8) as shown. Press seams open. Make 10 top/bottom row units.



3. Sew one white rectangle (Shape 8) to each side of one 4" finished square (Shape 1) as shown. Press seams open. Make 5 units.



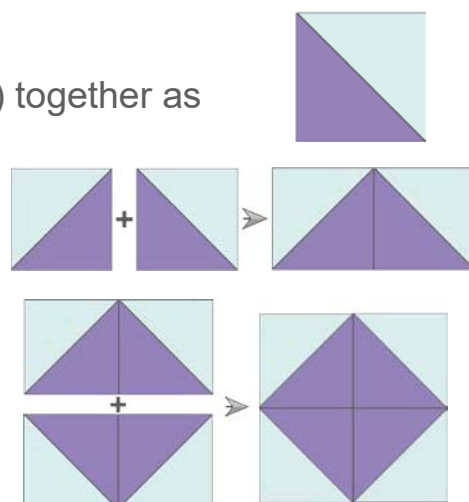
4. Pin and sew the three rows together to complete the large elephant block as shown. Press seams open. Make 5 large elephant blocks.



## Small Elephant Block

**NOTE: Make 4 Blocks.**

1. Sew one purple and one white 4" finished HST (Shape 3) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 16 HST units.
2. Sew two HST units together as shown to create 8 half block units. Press seams open.
3. Sew eight half block units together as shown to create four complete blocks. Press all seams open.



## Inner Border

1. Sew one purple and one white 4" finished HST (Shape 3) together as shown for the inner border. Press seams open. Make 28 HST units.
2. Stitch blocks together end to end to make four border units. The horizontal units will include the corner blocks and the vertical units will fit the inner quilt blocks exactly. Make two identical horizontal units and two identical vertical units.



## Elephant Appliqué

The elephants will be appliquéd onto the pieced quilt blocks. The large elephant will be stitched onto the Large Elephant Block and the small elephant will be stitched onto the Small Elephant Block. Detailed instructions are included with the free machine embroidery download from [www.accuquilt.com/elephants55373](http://www.accuquilt.com/elephants55373).

## Assemble Quilt Blocks

1. Lay out blocks as shown.
2. Pin and sew blocks into rows alternating Large and Small Elephant Blocks. Press seam allowance open or to one side.
3. Pin and sew rows together to complete the inner quilt top.



## Inner Border

1. Stitch the vertical pieced borders to the left and right sides of the quilt as shown. Pin carefully, easing quilt top as needed to fit the border.
2. Stitch the horizontal pieced borders to the top and bottom of the quilt as shown. Pin carefully, easing quilt top as needed to fit the border.
3. Press seam allowances open or toward the inner border.





## Outer Border

1. Cut the vertical and horizontal borders to size according to the cutting instructions.
2. Stitch the vertical outer border to the sides of the quilt first. Pin carefully, easing quilt top as needed to fit the border.
3. Stitch the outer border to the top and bottom of the quilt. Pin carefully, easing quilt top as needed to fit the border.
4. Press seam allowances toward the outer border.

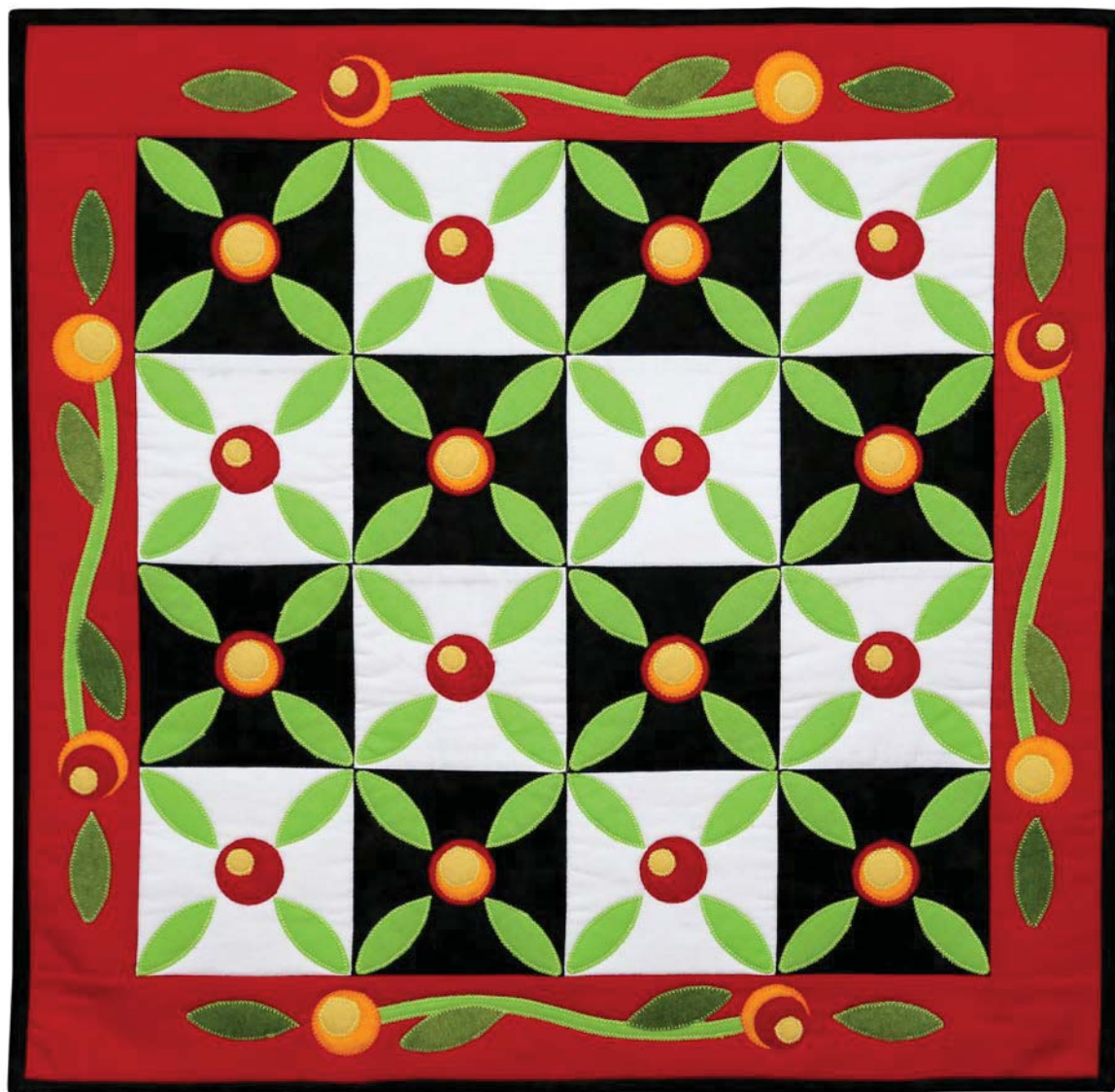


## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.

- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

*Yellow Wool	GO! Circle— $\frac{1}{2}$ ", $\frac{3}{4}$ ", 1", $1\frac{1}{4}$ " (55484)	Cut 1— $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" rectangle. Sub cut into 8— $\frac{1}{2}$ " circles. Cut 1— $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{4}$ " square. Sub cut into 4— $\frac{1}{2}$ " circles for a total of 12— $\frac{1}{2}$ " circles.	Yardage included above
*Green Wool	GO! Stems & Leaves (55331)	Cut 16—2" x $\frac{3}{4}$ " leaves	Fat eighth or large scrap
*Green Cotton	GO! Stems & Leaves (55331)	Cut 64—2" x $\frac{3}{4}$ " leaves	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard
*Green Cotton	GO! Stems & Leaves (55331)	Cut 4— $7\frac{11}{16}$ " x $\frac{13}{16}$ " stems	Yardage included above
Black Cotton	<div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 2px; display: inline-block;">1</div> (55776)	Cut 1—5" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 5" widths. Sub cut into 8—4" finished squares.	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard

## Additional Yardage and Cutting Instructions:

- Red Cotton—1/4 yard
  - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 2—2½" x WOF strips. Sub cut into 2—2½" x 16½" strips and 2—2½" x 20½" strips for borders.
- Black Cotton—yardage included above
  - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 3—2½" x WOF strips for binding.

- Fusible Web: 1/2 yard
- Batting: 26" x 26"
- Backing: 26" x 26"

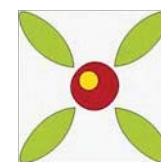
## Sewing Directions:

*Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

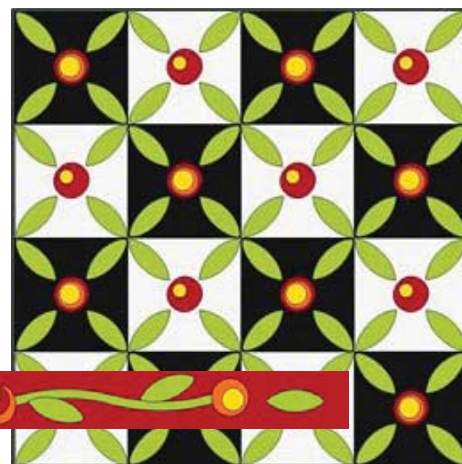
1. Lay out, center, fuse and/or fabric glue and appliqué 4—green cotton leaves, 1—red wool 1¼" circle, 1—orange wool 1" circle and 1—yellow ¾" circle on one black 4" finished square (Shape 1) as shown. Make sure not to cover the ¼" seam allowance. Make 8 blocks.



2. Lay out, center, fuse and/or fabric glue and appliqué 4—green cotton leaves, 1—red wool 1¼" circle and 1—yellow wool ½" circle on one white 4" finished square (Shape 2) as shown. Make sure not to cover the ¼" seam allowance. Make 8 blocks.



3. Lay out, pin and sew the 16 blocks in four rows of four. Alternate blocks for each row as shown. Press seams toward the black 4" finished square in each row. Pin and sew rows together to create quilt top. Press seams toward the added rows.

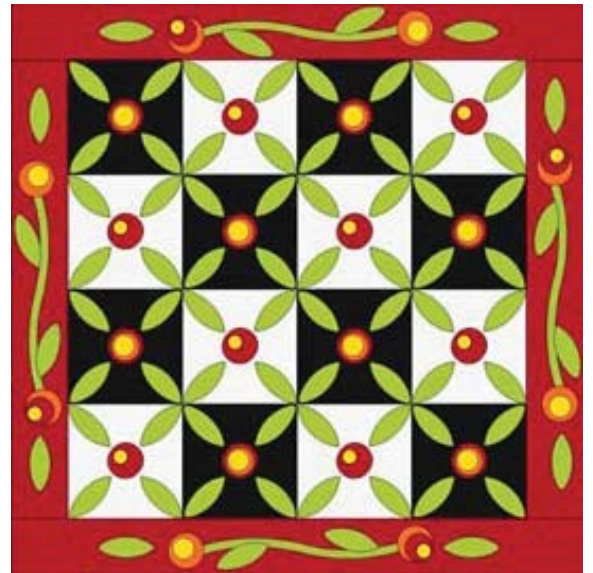


4. Lay out, center, fuse and/or fabric glue and appliqué 1—green cotton stem, 4—green wool leaves, 2—orange wool 1¼" circles, 1—red wool 1" circle, 1—yellow wool ¾" circle and 1—yellow wool ½" circle on 1—red cotton 2½" x 16½" strip as shown. Make two strip units.

5. Lay out, center, fuse and/or fabric glue and appliqué 1—green cotton stem, 4—green wool leaves, 2—orange wool  $1\frac{1}{4}$ " circles, 1—red wool 1" circle, 1—yellow wool  $\frac{3}{4}$ " circle and 1—yellow wool  $\frac{1}{2}$ " circle on 1—red cotton  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strip as shown. Make two strip units.



6. Pin and sew 1— $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $16\frac{1}{2}$ " strip unit to each side of the quilt top.
7. Pin and sew 1— $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $20\frac{1}{2}$ " strip unit on the top and bottom of the quilt top.

1. Layer batting between table topper and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add black binding, mitering corners.

# Confetti Lap Quilt

Dig into your stash for floral scraps and get started on this gorgeous lap quilt. All it takes is your time, scraps and three dies.

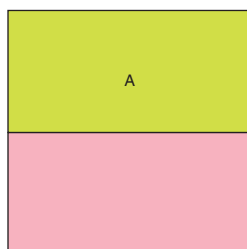

## Materials

- Assorted large and small pink, blue, green, white/cream scraps
- ¾ yard white/cream print
- 1¼ yards green print
- Thread
- 2½ yards paper-backed fusible web
- Backing to size
- Batting to size
- GO! Dies:
  - GO! Round Flower (55007)
  - GO! Rectangle—3½" x 6½" (3" x 6" Finished) (55005)
  - GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024)
  - Optional: GO! Strip Cutter-2¼" (1¾" Finished) (55053)
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

*\*Die not compatible with GO! Baby system.*

## Die-Cutting Instructions

### From assorted pink, blue, green, white/cream scraps:

- Cut 100 (4½" x 7½") rectangles. Stack 6 rectangles together or individually die-cut a total of 100 A rectangles using rectangle die.
- Follow manufacturer's instructions to fuse paper-backed fusible web to wrong side of remaining assorted scraps.

From fused scraps cut as follows:

26 (2") squares white/cream

16 (2½") squares pink

10 (4¼") squares pink

10 (2½") squares blue

10 (3½") squares green

12 (2" x 6½") rectangles green

- Place a fused scrap over the appropriate area of the Round Flower die and die-cut a total of:
  - 26 white/cream 1" flower centers
  - 16 pink star flowers
  - 10 pink flowers
  - 10 blue star centers
- Fold 3½"-square green fused scraps in half, fused sides together; press. Position over the leaf and die-cut a total of 10 leaves and 10 reversed leaves.
- Layer 2" x 6½"-rectangle green fused scraps, fused sides together, in pairs. Position layered scraps over the stem and die-cut a total of 6 stems and 6 reversed stems.
- Cut 2 (8½" by fabric width) strips. Fan-fold each strip 8½" wide and die-cut 10 strips for B/C/F/G using Strip Cutter-1½".

## Additional Cutting Instructions

### From white/cream print:

- Cut 5 (5" by fabric width) D/E strips.

### From green print:

- Cut 6 (2¼" by fabric width) strips for binding.

**\*\*TIP:** Use GO! Strip Cutter-2¼" to cut binding strips.





## Completing the Quilt

**1.** Sew two randomly chosen A rectangles together along long sides referring to block drawing to make a Confetti block. Repeat to make a total of 50 blocks.

**2.** Arrange blocks as desired in four rows referring to Figure 1, turning every other block in the row. Make 2 of each row.

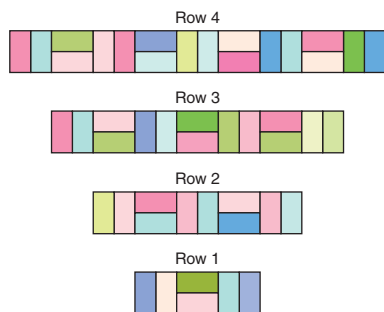

**3.** Stitch the blocks together in rows; press seams toward horizontal blocks.

**4.** Stitch one each rows 1–4 together diagonally, offsetting each row by one block referring to Figure 2. Stitch a block centered on row 1 to complete one half of the quilt center. Repeat to make second half.

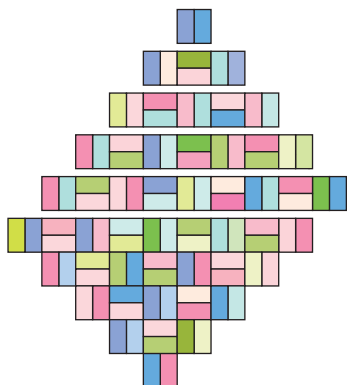

**5.** Stitch quilt halves together offsetting Row 4 and referring again to Figure 2 to complete the quilt center.

**6.** Trim the outer row of blocks  $\frac{1}{4}$ " beyond the inside points as shown in Figure 3. The pieced center should measure  $34\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43".

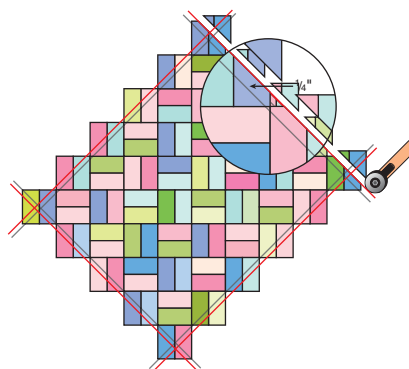
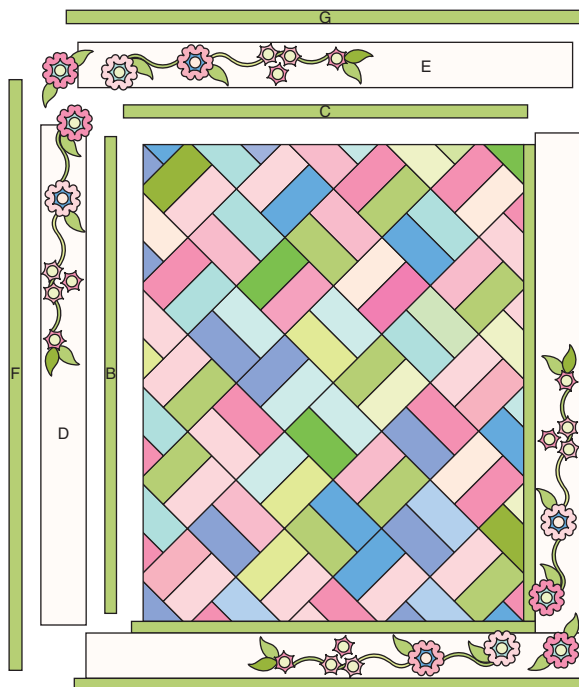

**7.** Stitch B/C/F/G strips together using an angled seam. Trim seam allowances to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press in one direction. Cut two each  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 43" B,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $36\frac{1}{2}$ " C,  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54" F and  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $47\frac{1}{2}$ " G borders.

**8.** Stitch D/E strips together using an angled seam; trim seam allowances to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press in one direction. Cut two each 5" x 45" D and 5" x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " E borders.

**9.** Stitch C borders to opposite sides of quilt center; press seams toward C. Stitch B borders to top and bottom of quilt center; press seams toward B.

**10.** Stitch E borders to opposite sides and D to top and bottom of quilt center; press seams toward B and C.

**11.** Stitch G borders to opposite sides and F to top and bottom of quilt; press seams toward F and G.

**12.** Arrange Round Flower appliqué pieces on borders as desired referring to Assembly Diagram and project photo for suggestions. Remove paper and fuse following manufacturer's directions.

**13.** Machine blanket-stitch around each appliqué piece with thread of your choice.

**14.** Layer, quilt and bind as desired.❖

### Fabric Requirements

For quilt as shown including 9 sampler blocks, sashing squares, borders and binding.

- Fabric 1 (White)—1 yard
- Fabric 2 (Dark Blue)—1/2 yard
- Fabric 3 (Light Blue)—1/2 yard
- Fabric 4 (Green)—1/2 yard

- Fabric 5 (Orange)—1/2 yard
- Fabric 6 (Pink)—1/2 yard
- Batting—at least 38" x 44"
- Backing—1½ yards

### Cutting Directions:

- Cut larger pieces before cutting smaller pieces.
- Follow cutting directions on each block page substituting the color placement shown in the quilt image above.
- **Fabric 1 (White):**
  - Cut 5—2½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014). Save one strip for the border and sub cut remaining strips into 12—2½" x 8½" sashing pieces.
  - Cut 4—3½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (3" Finished) (55032) for borders.
  - Cut 1—4½" strip using GO! Strip Cutter-4½" (4" Finished) (55054). Sub cut into 4½" x random lengths for parade border filler.
- **Your Fabric Choice from Fabric 2, Fabric 3, Fabric 4, Fabric 5 or Fabric 6:**
  - Cut 4—2½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014). Strips will be used for binding. Use leftover strips to lay across the 90° guideline to cut a total of 4—2½" squares.

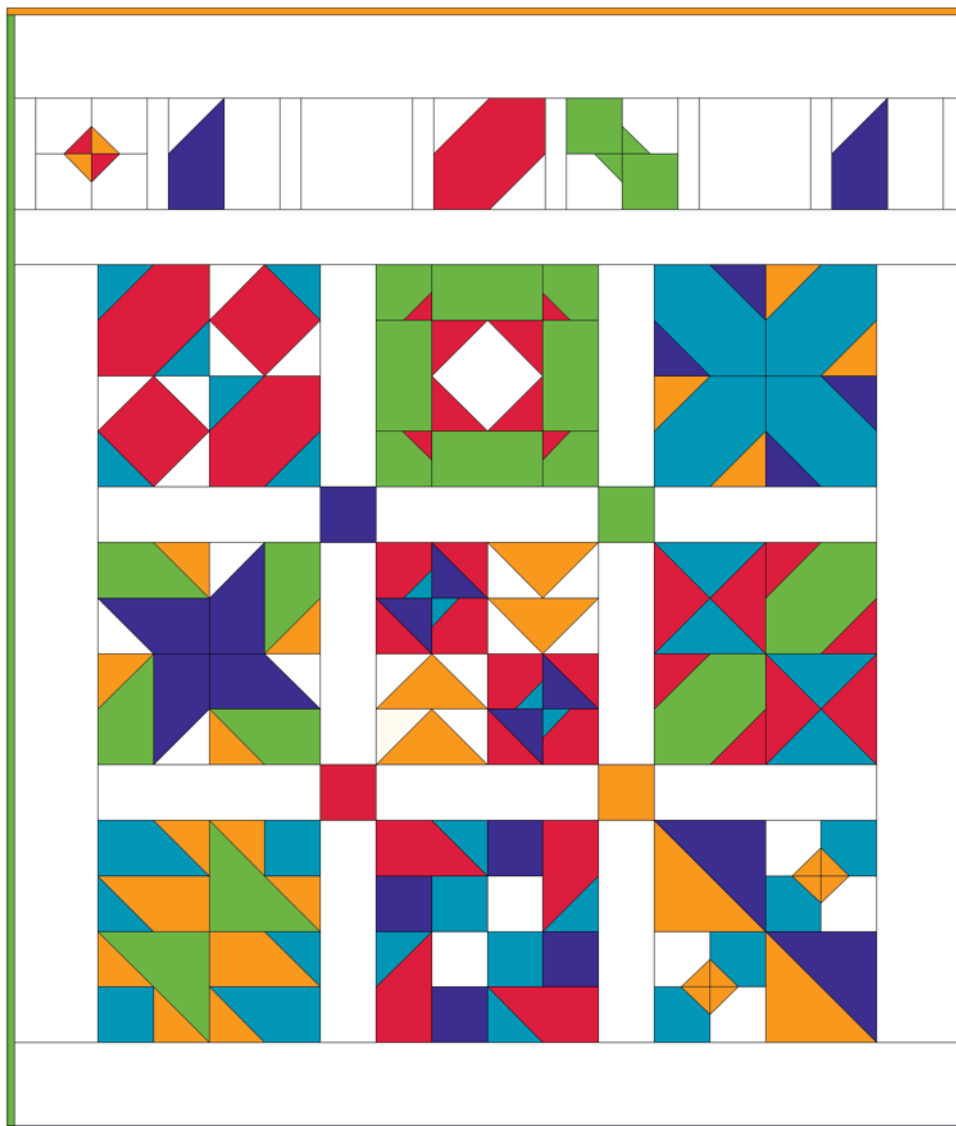
#### Sampler Blocks

- Make one each of the 9, 8" finished pieced sampler blocks included in this GO! Qube plus 5 partial blocks for the featured Parade Row at the top of the quilt.
- Use block directions to piece the following 8" finished blocks: Beveled Edge, Cheeky, Cross Cut, Dovetail, Folksy, Freehand, Hardcover, Longhand and Spiffy. **Fabric colors used in this Sampler Quilt are different than what is shown in the included individual block patterns.**
- Aim for an even distribution of colors to achieve a controlled scrappy look



## Parade Row Assembly

1. Choose your favorite partial blocks or make the ones shown in the quilt. Make 5 block parts from the GO! Qube™ 8" Companion Set - Corners (55785) to use in the featured Parade Row at the top of the quilt.
2. Arrange the 5 block parts as desired. Pin and sew the 4½" filler pieces between block parts until the row measures the same as the quilt top. Press seams towards filler pieces.
3. Pin and sew 2½" strip to bottom of parade row. Press towards the border.
4. Pin and sew 3½" strip to top of parade row. Press towards the border.
5. Pin and sew bottom border of parade row to top of quilt center. Press to border.



## Quilt Assembly

1. Lay out 9 blocks with sashing and cornerstones as shown.
2. Pin and sew horizontal block and sashing strip rows. Press to sashing strips.
3. Pin and sew horizontal sashing strips and cornerstones. Press to sashing strips.
4. Pin and sew block/sashing rows to sashing strip/cornerstone rows. Press to sashing rows.
5. Measure quilt and cut 2 border pieces that length from 2 of the 3½" strips.
6. Pin and sew border strips to right and left sides of quilt center. Press to borders.
7. Measure quilt and cut 2 border pieces that length from 2 of the 3½" strips and 1 from the 2½" strip.
8. Pin and sew one of the 3½" strips to bottom of quilt center. Press to border.

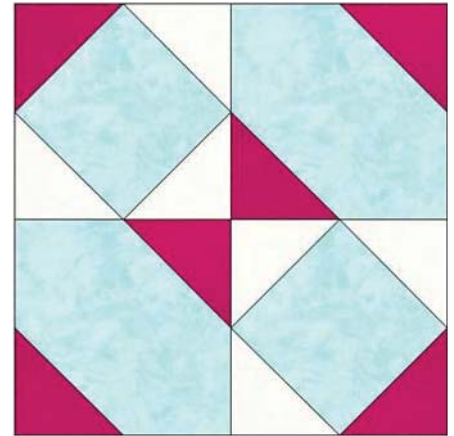
