Sewing Directions:

1. Lay out pieces to form one Log Cabin Block as shown.
2. Pin and sew one white 1½" square (1) to one dark red 1½" square (2) to form the center unit. Press seam toward dark red square.
3. Pin and sew one white 1½" x 2½" Rectangle (3) to the top on the center unit. Press seam toward added white rectangle.
4. Pin and sew one orange 1½" x 2½" Rectangle (4) to the right of the block unit. Press seam toward added orange rectangle.
5. Pin and sew one orange 1½" x 3½" Rectangle (5) to the bottom of the block unit. Press seam toward added orange rectangle.
6. Continue adding rectangular pieces by number following the block diagram, pressing toward the added pieces, making a 12½" x 12½" Log Cabin Block. Make four blocks.

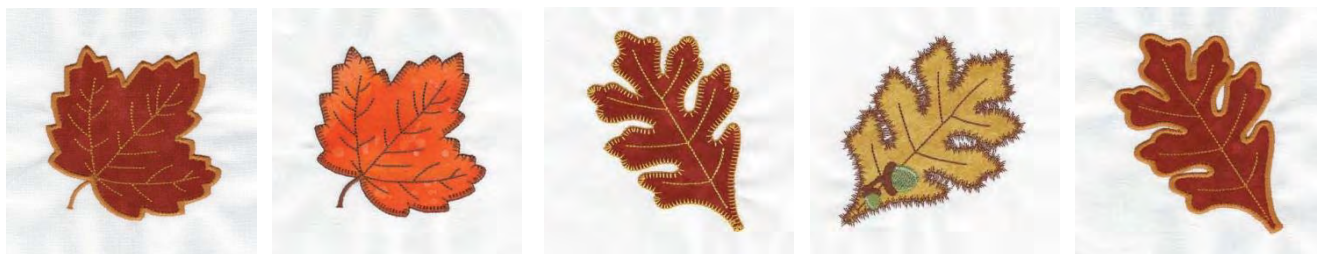


7. Following the instructions provided with the GO! Rustling Leaves Embroidery (VQ-RL1, VQ-RL2, VQ-RL3 and VQ-RL4) by V-Stitch Designs, machine appliqué each of the twenty rustling leaves blocks. Each single leaf is machine embroidered on one 6½" white square. Use the following block images as a reference.

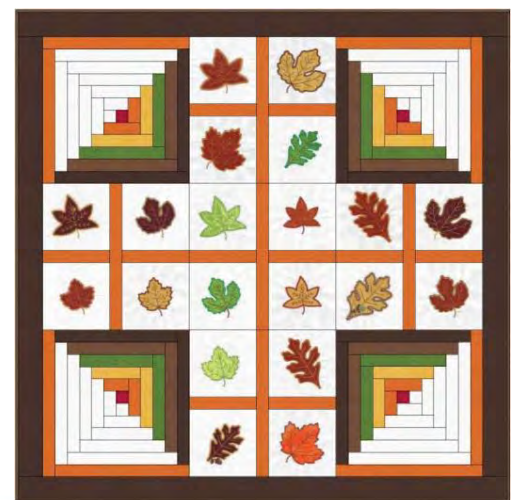
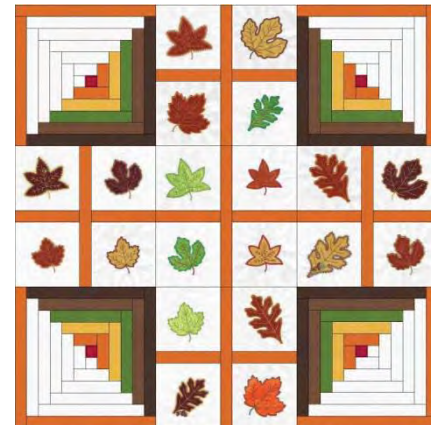
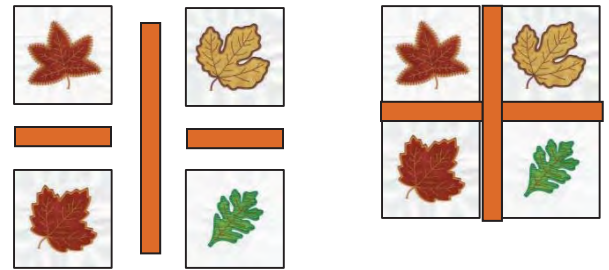

8. Trim each embroidered block to 6" square.
9. Lay out four 6" square embroidered leaf blocks, two 1½" x 6" rectangular strips, and one 1½" x 12½" rectangular strip to form one block, as shown. You may choose to use the quilt diagram for exact placement of the leaves or choose four random leaf blocks.
10. Pin and sew block. Make five blocks.
11. Lay out blocks according to wall hanging diagram.
12. Pin and sew blocks in horizontal rows. Press seams in alternate directions for each row.
13. Pin and sew rows together to complete wall hanging center. Press seams toward added rows.
14. Add dark brown 36½" side border strips. Press seams toward border.
15. Add dark brown 40½" top and bottom border strips. Press seams toward border.



Quilting & Finishing:

1. Layer batting between wall hanging top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add medium brown binding, mitering corners.







- **Cut strips 23½" across the width of fabric. Fan fold at 7". Place on blade and cut.**
- **Cut five block sets from the width of fabric.**
- **1 1/3 yards of 42" wide fabric cuts 5 block sets.**

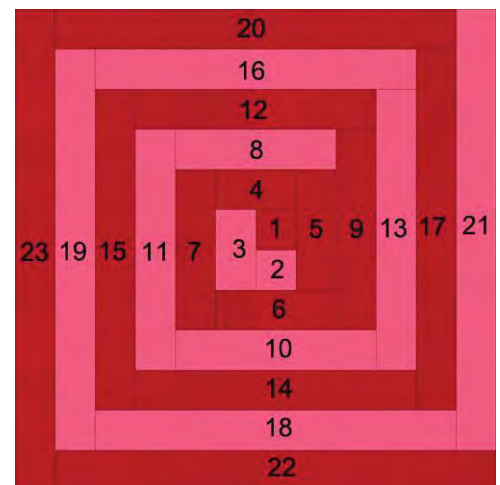
1. Lay out pieces to form one Log Cabin Block as shown (Block 1).
2. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (1) to one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (2) to form the center unit.
3. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (3) to the bottom of the center unit.
4. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (4) to the left of the block unit.
5. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (5) to the top of the block unit.
6. Continue adding rectangular pieces by number following the block diagram, making a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Log Cabin Block. Make **two** blocks.
7. Lay out pieces to form one Log Cabin Block as shown (Block 2).
8. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (1) to one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (2) to form the center unit.
9. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (3) to the bottom of the center unit.
10. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (4) to the right of the block unit.
11. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (5) to the top of the block unit.
12. Continue adding rectangular pieces by number following the block diagram, making a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Log Cabin Block. Make **two** blocks.



13. Lay out pieces to form one Log Cabin Block as shown (Block 3).
14. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (1) to one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (2) to form the center unit.
15. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (3) to the right of the center unit.
16. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (4) to the top of the block unit.
17. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (5) to the left of the block unit.
18. Continue adding rectangular pieces by number following the block diagram, making a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Log Cabin Block. Make **one** block.
19. Lay out pieces to form one Log Cabin Block as shown (Block 4).
20. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (1) to one pink $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (2) to form the center unit.
21. Pin and sew one pink $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (3) to the left of the center unit.
22. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (4) to the top of the block unit.
23. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (5) to the right of the block unit.
24. Continue adding rectangular pieces by number following the block diagram, making a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Log Cabin Block. Make **one** block.

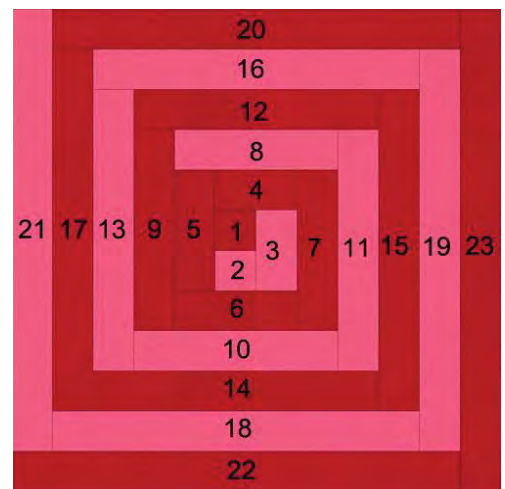

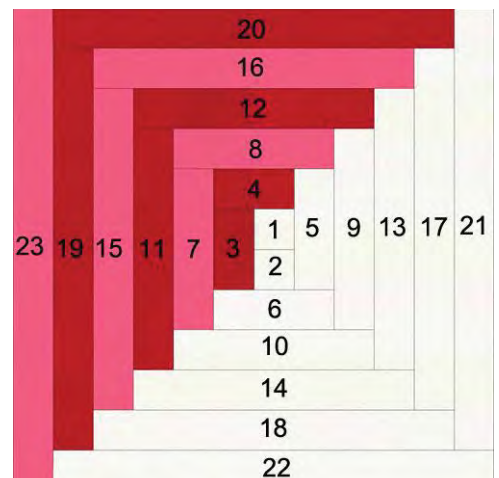

29. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (5) to the left of the block unit.

31. Layout pieces to form one Log Cabin Block as shown (Block 6).
32. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (1) to one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square (2) to form the center unit.
33. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (3) to the left of the center unit.
34. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (4) to the top of the block unit.
35. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (5) to the right of the block unit.
36. Continue adding rectangular pieces by number following the block diagram, making a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Log Cabin Block. Make **one** block.

57. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (3) to the right of the center unit.
58. Pin and sew one red $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (4) to the bottom of the block unit.
59. Pin and sew one white $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle (5) to the left of the block unit.
60. Continue adding rectangular pieces by number following the block diagram, making a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Log Cabin Block. Make **one** block.

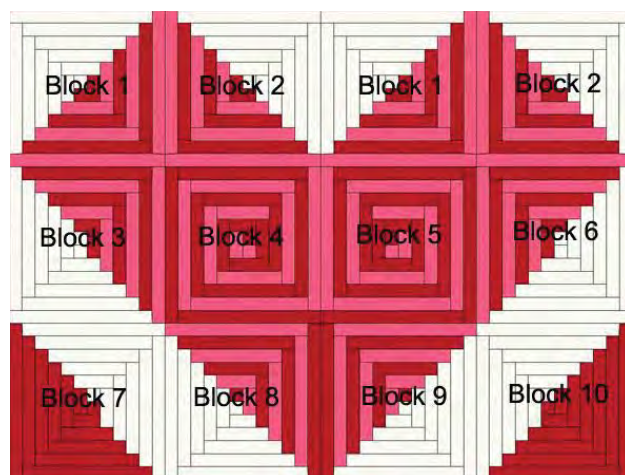

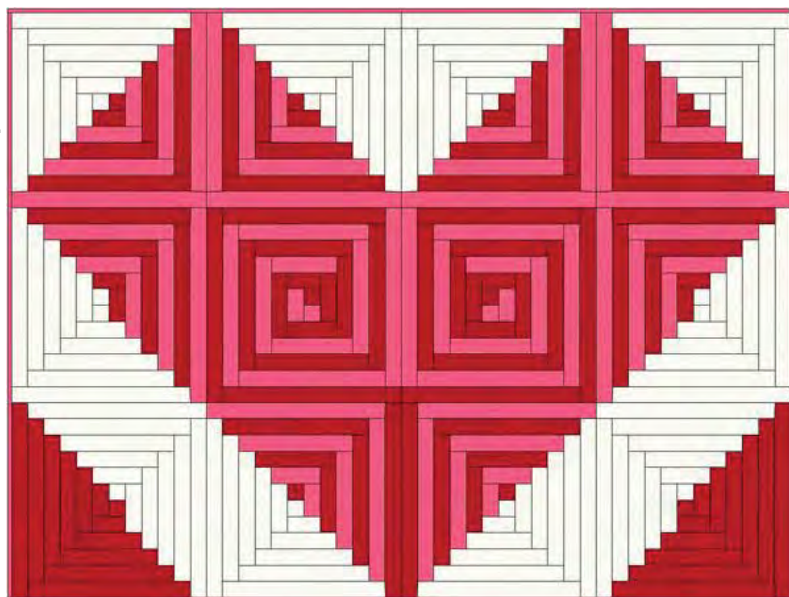

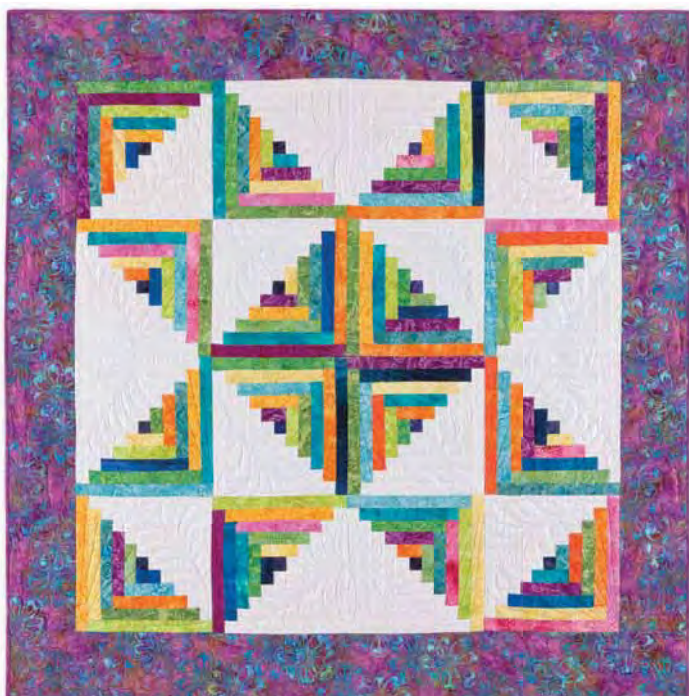

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—2½ yards total (lights)
16 pieces, 22½" x 7½" (lengthwise cuts)
- Fabric 2—2½ yards total (darks)
16 pieces, 22½" x 7½" (lengthwise cuts)
- Fabric 3—1¾ yards (for outer border)
- Fabric 4—¾ yard (for binding)
- Backing—65" x 65"
- Batting—65" x 65"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Fabric 1:

- Cut 16—(from various light fabrics): 22½" x 7½" strips on the lengthwise grain

Fabric 2:

- Cut 16—(from various dark fabrics): 22½" x 7½" strips on the lengthwise grain

Fabric 3:

- Cut 6—6½" strips across the width of fabric (WOF) by using GO! Strip Cutter-6½"

Fabric 4:

- Cut 6—2¼" strips across the WOF by using GO! Strip Cutter-2¼"

SEWING DIRECTIONS

TIP: Using mailing label stickers, label each die. (Placing the label inside away from the cutting blades.) Starting with the smallest rectangle as number one, increasing in size till you get to #12. The label number is the finished length of the log cabin log.

PIECING TIP: Press seams toward each added piece.

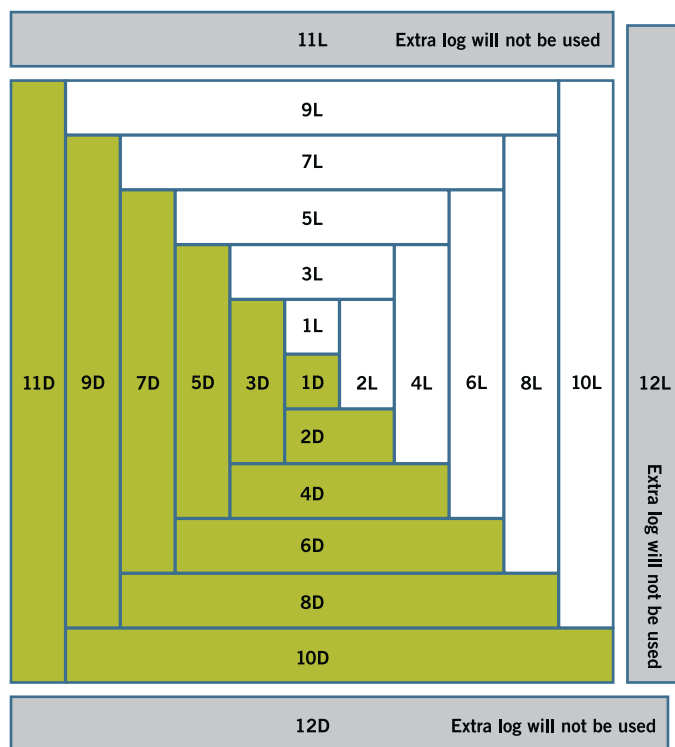
PIECING TIP: The unit just added should be at the top, when feeding the next unit through the machine.

1. Lay out pieces from one block following block diagram on following page.
2. Pin and sew piece 1L to the top of 1D (center block).
3. With the 1L square facing up, pin and sew piece 2L to the right side of 1L/1D center unit.
4. Pin and sew piece 2D to the bottom side of center unit.
5. Pin and sew piece 3D to the left side of center unit. The unit should measure 3½" x 3½".
6. Continue adding pieces by letter following block diagram, till you reach the desired block size. For the sample quilt, make 16, 11½" x 11½" unfinished blocks.
7. Lay out blocks according to photo.
8. Pin and sew into rows together to complete quilt center. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.
9. Add Fabric #3, 6½" strips for border. Press seams toward border.

QUILTING AND FINISHING

The Log Cabin design is licensed exclusively to AccuQuilt.

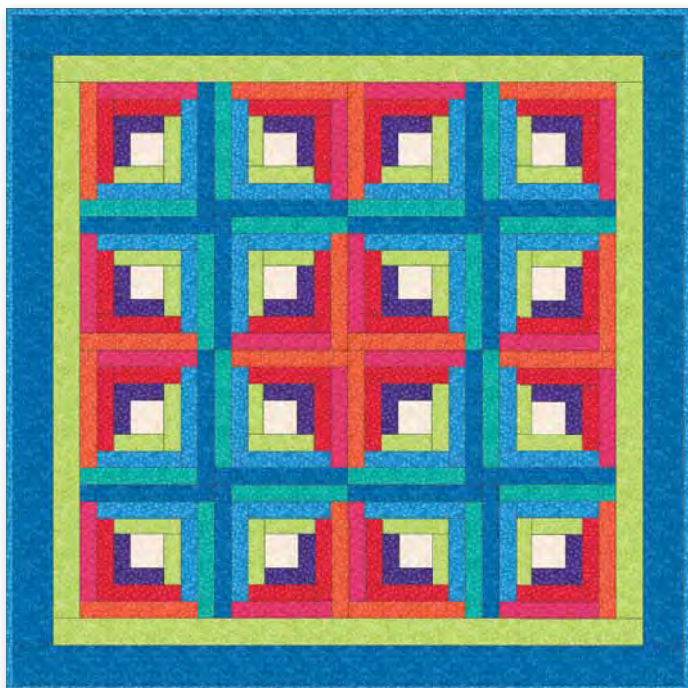
1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted with free-motion feathers in the light, and diagonal lines in the dark.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.

- Fabric 6—¼ yard
- Fabric 7—⅓ yard
- Fabric 8—⅓ yard
- Fabric 9—⅞ yard for blocks and outer border
- Backing—57" x 57"
- Batting—57" x 57"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

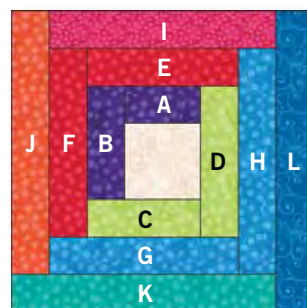
TIP: Label rectangle sizes with letters.

Fabric 1:

- Cut 2—3" strips across the width of fabric (WOF)
Sub cut into 16—3" squares for block centers

Fabric 2:

- Cut 1—4¼" strip across the WOF
Sub cut into 16—1¾" x 4¼" rectangles for piece B by using Cutter-1¾"
- Cut 1—3" strip across the WOF
Sub cut into 16—1¾" x 3" rectangles for piece A by using Strip Cutter-1¾"



Fabric 3:

- Cut 1—5½" strip across the WOF
Sub cut into 16—1¾" x 5½" rectangles for piece D by using Strip Cutter-1¾"
- Cut 1—4¼" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 4¼" rectangles for piece C by using Strip Cutter-1¾"
- Cut 5—2½" strips across the WOF for inner border

Fabric 4:

- Cut 1—6¾" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 6¾" rectangles for piece F by using Strip Cutter-1¾"
- Cut 1—5½" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 5½" rectangles for piece E by using Strip Cutter-1¾"

Fabric 5:

- Cut 1—8" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 8" rectangles for piece H by using Strip Cutter-1¾"
- Cut 1—6¾" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 6¾" rectangles for piece G by using Strip Cutter-1¾"
- Cut 6—2½" strips across the WOF for binding

CUTTING DIRECTIONS Cont.

Fabric 6:

- Cut 1—8" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 8" rectangles for piece I by using Strip Cutter-1¾"

Fabric 7:

- Cut 1—9¼" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 9¼" rectangles for piece J by using Strip Cutter-1¾"

Fabric 8:

- Cut 1—9¼" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 9¼" rectangles for piece K by using Strip Cutter-1¾"

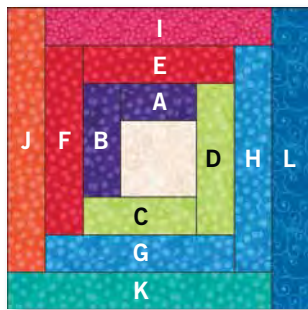
Fabric 9:

- Cut 1—10½" strip across the WOF
Sub cut 16—1¾" x 10½" rectangles for piece L by using Strip Cutter-1¾"
- Cut 5—3½" strips across the WOF for outer border

SEWING DIRECTIONS

TIP: Press seams toward each added piece.

1. Lay out pieces for one block following block diagram.
2. Pin and sew piece A to the top of center square.
3. Pin and sew piece B to the left side of center square unit.
4. Pin and sew piece C to the bottom of center square unit.
5. Continue adding pieces by letter following block diagram. Make 16 blocks.
6. Lay out blocks according to photo.
7. Pin and sew into rows. Press seams of each row in opposite directions.
8. Pin and sew rows together to complete quilt center. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.
9. Add Fabric #3, 2½" strips for inner border. Press seams toward inner border.
10. Add Fabric #9, 3½" strips for outer border. Press seams toward inner border.



QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
