

Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 6" finished units, 12" finished Hunter Star block:





Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Cut four layers of one fabric color, then reload and cut four layers of your second fabric color.

- Cut 10¼" strips across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 4" widths. Place on selected blades and cut. Cut 10 half Hunter Star units across width of fabric. One yard of 40" wide fabric cuts 30 half Hunter Star units.

How to Sew the Hunter's Star Quilt Block:

Step 1



Remove cut pieces from die and lay out your pieces as shown.

Step 2




Sew one Fabric #1
A diamond onto one Fabric #2
B trapezoid.

Step 3



Sew one Fabric #1 AR
diamond onto the other end of
Fabric #2 B trapezoid.

Step 4



Sew one Fabric #2 C triangle
onto the A/B/AR unit to
complete Unit #1.

Step 5




Sew one Fabric #2
A diamond onto one Fabric #1
B trapezoid.

Step 6




Sew one Fabric #2 AR
diamond onto the other end of
Fabric #1 B trapezoid.

Step 7




Sew one Fabric #1 C triangle
onto the A/B/AR unit to
complete Unit #2.

Step 8



Sew one Unit #1 onto Unit #2
along the longest side.

Step 9



Lay out Hunter Star Blocks
alternating between Unit #1
and Unit #2 turning as needed.
