Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 9" finished Crossed Canoes block:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:
For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller.

- TIP: To create a two-color Crossed Canoes Block: Cut two layers of one fabric color and two layers of contrasting fabric color at a time.
- Cut $61 / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into $61 / 4$ " widths. Place on selected blade and cut. For a two-color design, six cuts across the width of fabric yield enough pieces for six complete blocks. One yard of 40" wide fabric in each color will yield 30 blocks.

## Step 1



Sew piece $B$ to piece $C$. Make 4.

## Step 3



Sew piece $A R$ to $A / B / C$. Make 4 quarter units.

## Step 2



Sew piece $A$ to piece $B / C$. Make 4.

Step 4


Sew two units together to make two half blocks.
