Fabric Cutting Tips for a 6-color, 10" finished Courtyard block:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:
For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 6-color 10 " block in one pass through the cutter.

- Fabric Color 1: Cut one 3" square. Place right side up over shape $A$ to cut.
- Fabric Color 2: Cut four $3^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shape B to cut.
- Fabric Color 3: Cut four $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 4$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shape C to cut.
- Fabric Color 4: Cut four 533" $\times$ x $3^{\text {" rectangles. Place right side up }}$ over shapes D1 and D2 to cut.
- Fabric Color 5: Cut four 8" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes E1, E2, ER1 and ER2 to cut.
- Fabric Color 6: Cut four 6" squares. Place right side up over shape F to cut.


## Shapes needed for 10" finished Courtyard



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How to Sew the Courtyard Block:

## Step 1



Lay out cut pieces.

Step 4


Sew piece $C$ to piece $B$ as shown. Make four $C / B$ units.

## Step 7



Apply fusible web to wrong side of fabric before cutting circle A, then applique onto the middle of the block. Download free embroidery to finish edges.

Step 2


Sew piece E1 to piece D1 as shown. Make four E1/D1 units. Sew E1/D1 unit to piece ER1 as shown. Make four E1/D1/ER1 units.

Step 5


Sew C/B units together into a ring as shown.

Step 8


Sew F shapes together on the short ends first then around block, carefully matching up notches on both the F shapes and the lavendar E/D units. Finished block should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Step 3



Sew piece E2 to piece D2 as shown. Make four E2/D2 units. Sew E2/D2 unit to piece ER2 as shown. Make four E2/D2/ER2 units.

Step 6


On the back of E1/D1/ER1 and E2/D2/ER2 units, mark $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance in on wrong side of fabric on the two straight sides. Align these units between flower petals and sew Y-seams. Repeat all the way around alternating E1/D1/ER1 units with E2/D2/ER2 units to keep grain consistent.
