Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 6" finished Snowball block:


## Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. For 2-color block, cut one snowball center from first fabric color and four half square triangles from a contrasting fabric color.

- Snowball Center: Cut and fuse 7" squares. Cut five snowball centers across the width of fabric. One yard of 40" wide fabric cuts 25 snowball centers.
- Half Square Triangles: Cut a $31 / 2$ " strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 3" widths. Place on selected blade and cut. Cut 26 half square triangles across the width of fabric. One yard of 40 " wide fabric cuts 260 half square triangles.

How to Sew the Snowball Quilt Block:

## Step 1



Sew piece $B$ to top left corner of piece A.

Step 2


Sew another piece B to top right corner of piece $A$.

Step 3


Continue sewing piece $B$ to each corner of piece $A$.

Step 4


Completed Snowball block.
