Fabric Cutting Tips for one 3-color, 10" finished Friendship Chain block:


Shapes needed for 10" finished Friendship Chain Block


C Shapes (cut together Purple, Dark Blue \& White)
2 Purple (1 layer) 4 Dark Blue (2 layers) 2 White (1 layer)


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:
For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 3-color 10" finished block in one pass through the cutter.

- Fabric Color 1 (Purple): Cut two $73 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes A to cut four shapes.
- Cut one $5^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4$ " rectangle. Place right side up over shapes B to cut two shapes.
- Cut one $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " rectangle. Place right side up over shapes C to cut two shapes.
- Fabric Color 2 (Dark Blue): Cut two $5^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes B to cut four shapes.
- Cut two $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes $C$ to cut four shapes.
- Fabric Color 3 (White): Cut two $73 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes A to cut four shapes.
- Cut one $5^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4$ " rectangle. Place right side up over shapes B to cut two shapes.
- Cut one $43 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Place right side up over shapes C to cut two shapes.

How to Sew the 3-color, 10" finished Friendship Chain Block:
Read through assembly instructions before starting sewing. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed in pattern.

## Step 1



Sew dark B piece to medium tone A piece as shown. Make 2 A/B units. Sew dark $C$ piece to other side of medium tone A piece as shown.

Make 2 A/B/C units.

Step 4


Sew medium tone $B$ piece to light A piece as shown. Make $2 A / B$ units. Sew medium tone $C$ piece to other side of light A piece as shown. Make 2 A/B/C units.


Sew light B piece to medium tone $A$ piece as shown. Make $2 A / B$ units. Sew light C piece to other side of medium tone A piece as shown. Make $2 \mathrm{~A} / \mathrm{B} / \mathrm{C}$ units.

## Step 5



Sew $A / B / C$ units with medium tone A together. Make 2 quarter units.

## Step 7



Sew quarter units into rows, then sew rows together to complete block.

## Step 3



Sew dark B piece to light A piece as shown. Make $2 A / B$ units.
Sew dark $C$ piece to other side of light $A$ piece as shown. Make $2 A / B / C$ units.

## Step 6



Sew $A / B / C$ units with light $A$ together. Make 2 quarter units.

## Step 8



Block should measure $101 / 2$ " $\times 10^{1 ⁄ 2}$ ".
