Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 10" finished Pineapple block:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:
For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller.

- Fabric Color 1: Cut one $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ square over shape $A$ and cut; then cut two $33 / 4^{1 "} \times 33 / 4$ " squares over
shape $H$ and cut; and finally cut four 9 " $\times 35 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles over shapes C/E/F/G and cut.
- Fabric Color 2: Cut four $7 \not 1 / 2^{11} \times 35 / 8^{1 "}$ rectangles over shapes B/D/E/F and cut.

Shapes needed for 2-color, 10" finished Pineapple


Step 1


Sew piece $B$ to each side of piece $A$. Sew on opposite sides as shown.

Step 2


Sew piece $C$ to $A / B$. Sew on opposite sides as shown.

Step 3


Sew piece $D$ to $A / B / C$. Sew on opposite sides as shown.

## Step 4



Sew piece E to A/B/C/D. Sew on opposite sides as shown.

Step 5


Sew another piece $E$ to $A / B / C / D / E$. Sew on opposite sides as shown.

Step 7

Step 8

Sew piece $G$ to $A / B / C / D / E / E / F / F$. Sew on opposite sides as shown.


Step 6


Sew piece $F$ to $A / B / C / D / E / E$. Sew on opposite sides as shown.


Sew another piece $F$ to $A / B / C / D / E / E / F$. Sew on opposite sides as shown.

Step 9


Sew piece $H$ to $A / B / C / D / E / E / F / F / G$. Sew on opposite sides as shown.
