



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
Fabric Cutting Tips for a 5-color, 12" finished Basket of Lilies block:





Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

- Fabric Color 1 (background):
 - Cut one 25/8" square. Place right side up over shape A to cut.
 - Cut two 81/4" x 8" rectangles. Place right side up over shapes ABCDE to cut.
 - Cut one 5\%" x 9\%" rectangle. Place right side up over shapes F and L to cut.
- Fabric Color 2 (stems):
 - Cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{5}{8}$ " rectangle. Place right side up over shape K to cut.
 - Cut one $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle. Place right side up over shapes J and K to cut.
 - Cut two pre-fused, fanfolded 45%" x 13%" rectangles. Place over shape N to cut.
 - Cut one pre-fused 5" x 1" rectangle. Place right side up over shape M to cut.
- Fabric Colors 3 & 4 (petals):
 - Cut three layers each color 7¼" x 2¼" rectangles. (Can be fanfolded or not, outcome is the same). Place over shapes G and GR to cut.
- Fabric Colors 5 (vase):
 - Cut one 3½" square. Place over shape H to cut.
 - Cut one 6% square. Place right side up over shapes H and I to cut.

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How to Sew the 5-color, 12" finished Basket of Lilies Block:

*For easy Y seams, be sure to mark your 1/4" point on the wrong side of all pieces where they intersect. You will want to sew Shapes A, B and C by starting at the outside, sewing to the 1/4" mark and stopping. Then flip the piece to sew from the outside to the center again. Do not overlap your stitches. Backstitching when stopping will help secure the seam.

Step 1




Sew G to GR pieces, making 2 sets of the first two and 1 set of the last two per the diagram in Step 10. Note: stop sewing 1/4" from the top to allow for the Y seam in the next step.

Step 2




Sew pieces A, B and C onto your G/GR units, sewing a Y seam* and following the diagram for placement. Each lily is different and directional.

Step 3




Sew the A/G/GR units to the B/G/GR units. You will have mirror images. Note: stop sewing 1/4" from the edge to allow for the Y seam. Sew the C/GR/G units together, again stopping 1/4" from the edge.

Step 4




Sew Shape C to each A/B/G/GR unit as shown, using a Y seam. These are the side lilies. Sew your remaining Shape A onto the C/G/GR unit, using a Y seam. This is the center lily.

Step 5



Sew Shape J onto the center lily and a Shape K onto each of the side lilies:

Step 6




Sew Shape D onto either side of the center lily.

Step 7




Apply fusible web to wrong side of fabric before cutting shapes M and N, fan folding over shape N when you cut, then applique onto Shape L. Download free embroidery to finish edges.

Step 8




Sew the side lilies to the stem block. Sew the center lily and Shape I to this unit.

Step 9



Sew shapes E and H together following diagram.

Step 10



Sew E/H units to the block. Sew shape F onto block. Finished block should measure 12½" square.
