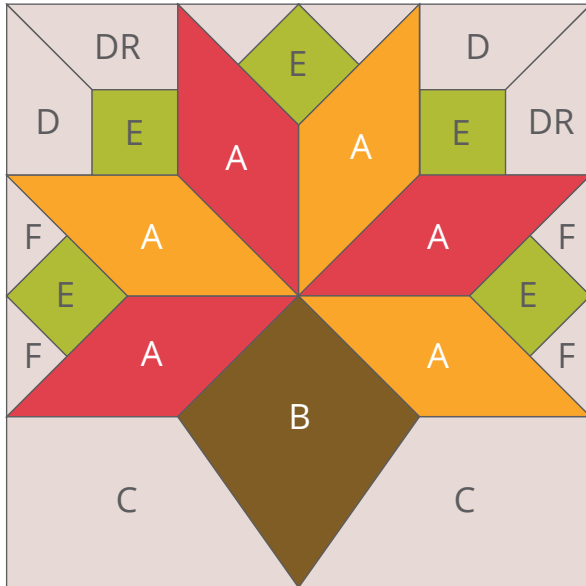




## GO!® Cornucopia-10" Finished

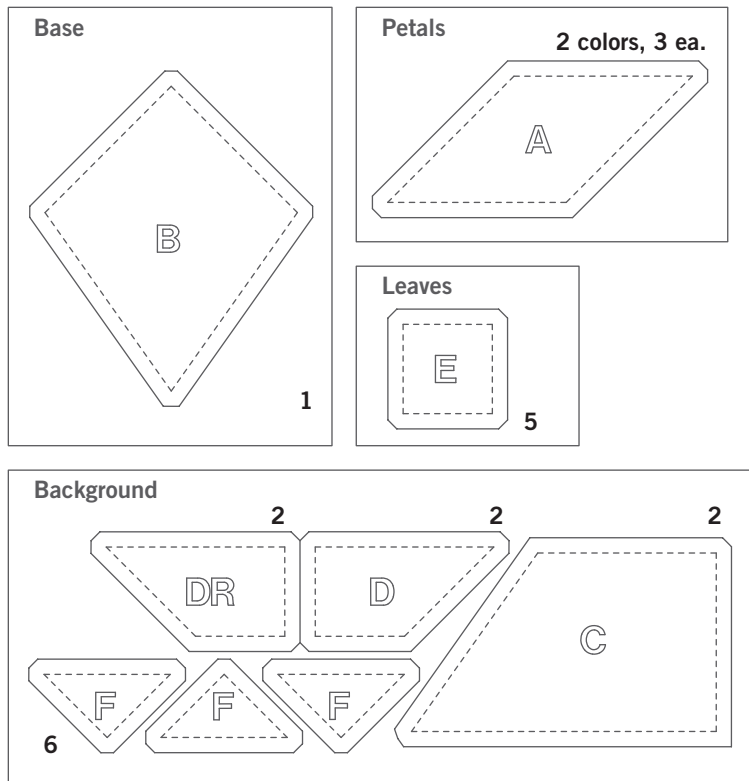
### Fabric Cutting Tips for a 5-color, 10" finished Cornucopia block:



#### Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

- Fabric Color 1 (red):
  - For 3 A shapes: Cut three 6" x 3½" rectangles. Place right side up over shape A to cut.
- Fabric Color 2 (orange):
  - For 3 A shapes: Cut three 6" x 3½" rectangles. Place right side up over shape A to cut.
- Fabric Color 3 (brown):
  - For 1 B shape: Cut one 5¼" x 6" rectangle. Place right side up over shape B to cut.
- Fabric Color 4 (green):
  - For 5 E shapes: Cut five 2½" squares. Place right side up over shape E to cut.
- Fabric Color 5 (background):
  - For 2 C, 2 ea. D/DR & 6 F shapes: Cut 12½" x 8½" rectangle. Fanfold in half and place over shapes C/D/DR/F to cut.

### How to Sew the 5-color, 10" finished Cornucopia Block:

Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed. \*For easy Y seams, be sure to mark your 1/4" point on the wrong side of all pieces where they intersect. You will want to sew by starting at the outside, sewing to the 1/4" mark and stopping. Then flip the piece to sew from the outside to the center again. Do not overlap your stitches. Backstitching when stopping will help secure the seam.

#### Step 1



Sew 2 of piece A together as shown. Make 2 A/A units. *Note: Stop sewing 1/4" from the edge to allow for the Y seam.*

#### Step 2



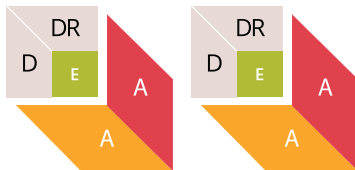
Sew 2 of piece F to either side of piece E as shown. Make 3 F/E/F units.

#### Step 3



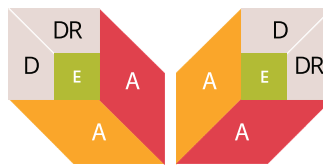
Sew piece D and piece DR to either side of piece E as shown sewing a Y seam and following the diagram for placement. Make 2 D/E/DR units.

#### Step 4



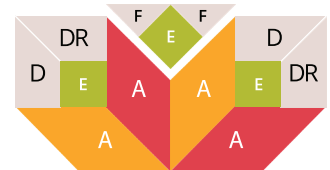
Sew a D/E/DR unit to a A/A unit with a Y seam as shown. Make 2 D/E/DR/A/A units.

#### Step 5



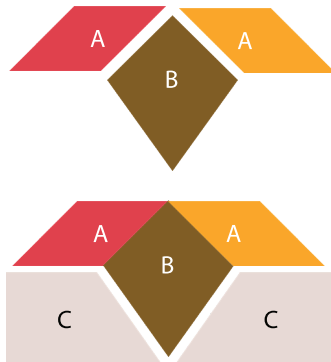
Sew the 2 D/E/DR/A/A units together as shown.

#### Step 6



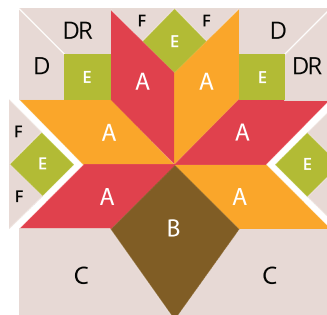
Sew a F/E/F unit to both D/E/DR/A/A units using a Y seam as shown.

#### Step 7



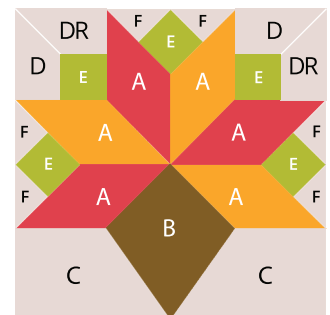
Sew 2 of piece A to a piece B as shown. Sew a piece C to either side of the A/B/A unit using a Y seam as shown.

#### Step 8



Sew the 2 halves together. Sew 2 F/E/F units using a Y seam to either side as shown.

#### Step 9



Block should measure 10 1/2" square.
