Fabric Cutting Tips for a 3-color, 16 " finished Feather Star block:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

## - Fabric Color 1:

- Cut one $65 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Place right side up over shape $A$ to cut.
- Cut four $3^{77} / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place right side up over shapes D to cut.
- Cut four $61 / 21 \times 41 / 2$ " rectangles, fanfolded in half. Place right side up over shapes F to cut.


## - Fabric Color 2:

- Cut four 51/4" squares. Place right side up over shape B to cut.
- Cut four $85 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shape $C$ to cut.
- Cut three $6^{1 ⁄ 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{11 / 2 "}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes $G$ to cut.
- Cut four $47 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes I to cut.


## - Fabric Color 3:

- Cut four $2^{11 / 4 " x} \times 4^{4}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes H and E to cut.
- Cut two $61 / 21 \times 31 / 2$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes $G$ to cut.
- Cut two $478^{\prime \prime} \times 25 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes I to cut.

How to Sew the 3-color, 16 " finished Feather Star Block:
Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press as directed. *For easy $Y$ seams, be sure to mark your $1 / 4$ " point on the wrong side of all pieces where they intersect. You will want to sew shape C by starting at the outside, sewing to the $1 / 4 / 4$ mark and stopping. Then flip the piece to sew from the outside to the center again. Do not overlap your stitches. Backstitching when stopping will help secure the seam.

## Step 1



Note: Fanfold fabric to cut F shapes for a total of four F shape sets. Select two I colors and sew together as shown. Make 4 units.
Next sew F shapes to I shapes as shown to make F/I units. Make 2 units facing left and 2 units facing right. Sew F/I units to I/I units. Make 2 F/II/II units facing left and 2 units facing right.

Step 2


Sew $B$ shape to $F / I / I / I$ units as shown. Make $2 \mathrm{~B} / \mathrm{F} / \mathrm{I} / \mathrm{I} / \mathrm{I}$ units facing left and 2 units facing right.

## Step 5



Sew a G shape and $E$ shape to either side of a $G / G / G / G$ unit (from step 3) as shown. Next sew right facing F shape to unit G/G/G/G/G/E. Make 2 units. Then sew $\mathrm{F} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{E}$ to the right side of the unit created in step 4. Make 2 units.

Step 8


Sew a G/G/G/G/G unit and a G/G/G/G/G/E unit as shown. Next sew a $D$ shape onto the $G / G / G / G / G / E$ unit. Then sew the units together. Add another shape $D$ as shown. Sew 2 complete units onto either side of shape A as shown.

## Step 3



Select two G colors and sew together as shown. Make 16 units.
Next sew $2 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{G}$ units together as shown. Make $4 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{G}$ units.
Next sew a left F shape to a $G$ shape as shown. Make $2 \mathrm{~F} / \mathrm{G}$ units.
Then sew $F / G$ to $G / G / G / G$ as shown. Make 2 units.

## Step 6



Sew together 3 I shapes as shown. Next sew $H$ shape to I/I/I unit as shown. Then sew shape D to H/II//I unit. Make 2 units.
Follow the same steps to make 2 additional mirror image units.

## Step 9



Note: Stop sewing $1 / 4$ " from the edge to allow for the $Y$ seam in the next step.
Sew rows together then add 2 shape C's to the sides as shown.
Block should measure $161 / 2$ " square.
