Fabric Cutting Tips for a 5-color, 14" finished Prairie Star block:


Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

- Fabric Color 1 (Dark Red):
- For 8 A shapes: Cut four 5 5/8" x $2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over row of 2 A shapes to cut.
- Fabric Color 2 (Orange):
- For 16 A shapes: Cut four $10^{1 / 8 "} \times 2$ " rectangles. Place right side up over one row of 4 A shapes to cut.
- Fabric Color 3 (Cream):
- For 16 A shapes: Cut four $101 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ " rectangles. Place right side up over one row of 4 A shapes to cut.
- Fabric Color 4 (Pink):
- For 32 A shapes: Cut six $14^{5} / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over row of 6 A shapes to cut. (There will be 4 extra shapes.)
- Fabric Color 5 (Background):
- For 4 B \& C shapes: Cut four $67 / 8^{11} \times 9^{1 / 2 "}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes $B$ and $C$ to cut.


## Shapes needed for 14" finished Prairie Star

## Diamond (Dark Red)




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How to Sew the 5-color, 14" finished Prairie Star Block:
*For easy $Y$ seams, be sure to mark your $1 / 4$ " point on the wrong side of all pieces where they intersect. Sew shapes by starting at the outside, sewing to the $1 / 4$ " mark and stopping. Then flip the piece to sew from the outside to the center again. Do not overlap your stitches. Backstitching when stopping will help secure the seam.

Step 1

*Tip: Lay out block shapes before assembling. Sew two A pieces together to create an A/A unit as shown. Make 8.

Step 4


Sew another $A / A / A$ unit to the existing $A / A / A$ units as shown. Make 8 total units.

Step 7


Sew 2 units together as shown. Sew Shape C to the unit as shown using a $Y$ seam. Make 2 units.

Step 2

## A A A

Sew another A piece to the A/A unit as shown. Make 8.

Step 5


Sew two 'A' units together. Make 4 units.

Step 8


Sew mirrored units together following diagram.

Step 3


Continue to sew A/A/A units together as shown. Make 8.


Sew Shape B to the 'A' unit using a $Y$ seam. Make 4 units.

Step 9


Sew $C$ units to the side of the block using a Y seam. Block should measure $141122^{\prime \prime}$ square.
