Fabric Cutting Tips for a 5-color, 10" finished Lotus Block:


Shapes needed for 10 " finished Lotus Block

For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 5-color 10" finished block in one pass through the cutter.

- Fabric Color 1 (blue/background):
- Cut one $31 / 2$ " square. Place right side up over shapes A to cut two shapes.
- Cut four 23/4" squares. Place right side up over shapes B to cut eight shapes.
- Cut C and D shapes together. Cut one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Fanfold into two layers and place over shapes $C$ and $D$ to cut a mirrored shape set of each.
- Fabric Color 2 (green): Cut two $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Fanfold into four layers and place over shape E to cut two mirrored shape sets.
- Fabric Color 3 (dark green):
- Cut one 31212 square. Place right side up over shapes $A$ to cut two shapes. There will be one extra shape.
- Cut F and G shapes together. Cut two $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place right side up over shapes $F$ and $G$ to cut four $F$ and two $G$ shapes.
- Fabric Color 4 (pink): Cut I and K shapes together. Cut one $81 / 2$ " x $83 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Fanfold into two layers and place over shapes I and K to cut two mirrored shape sets of each.
- Fabric Color 5 (dark pink): Cut H and J shapes together. Cut one 4" x 11" rectangle. Fanfold into two layers and place over shapes H and J to cut two mirrored shape sets of each.




## GO! ${ }^{\circledR}$ Lotus Block-10" Finished

How to Sew the 5 -color, 10" finished Lotus Block: Use a $1 / 41$ seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed.

Step 1


Sew A piece to K piece to create A/K units as shown. Make 1 facing right and 1 facing left.

Step 2


Sew $B$ piece to $J$ piece to create $B / J$ units. Sew $B$ piece to I piece to create $B / I$ units. Make 1 facing right and 1 facing left of each.

Step 5


Sew C, E, F \& G pieces and D, E \& F pieces together as shown, lining up notches to create $C / E / F / G$ and $D / E / F$ units. Make 1 of each unit.

Step 3


Sew a B piece to either side of H piece to create $\mathrm{B} / \mathrm{B} / \mathrm{H}$ units. Make

1 facing right and 1 facing left.

Step 6


Sew C, E \& F pieces and D, E, F \& G pieces together as shown, lining up notches to create C/E/F and D/E/F/G units. Make 1 of each unit.

## Step 7



Sew C/E/F unit (from step 6) to right side of Lotus flower unit (from step 4) as shown.

Step 9


To complete block, sew D/E/F/G unit (from step 6) to the right side as shown.

Step 10


Block should measure 10½" square.
