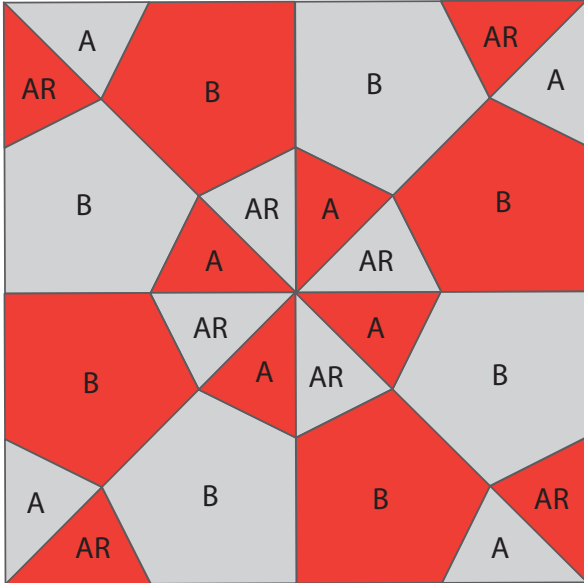

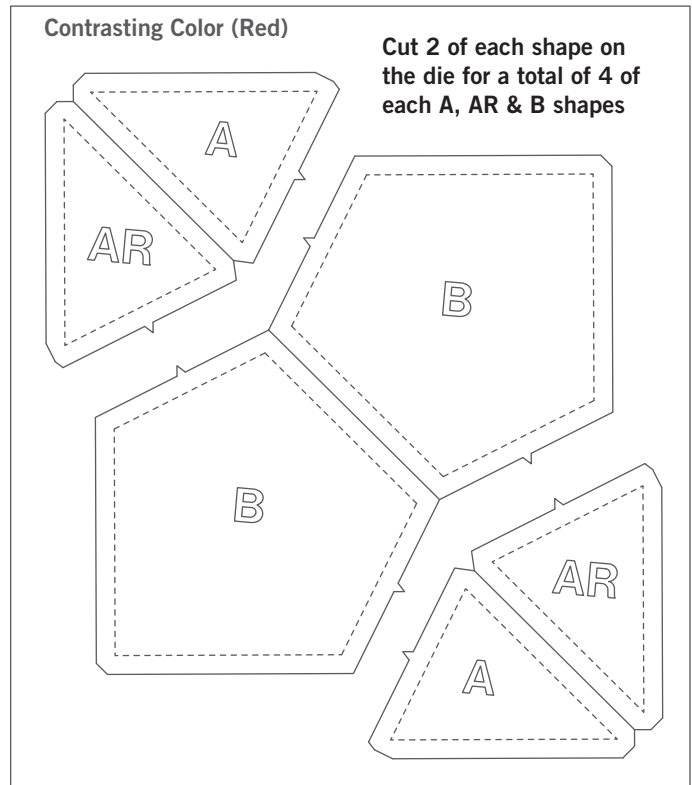
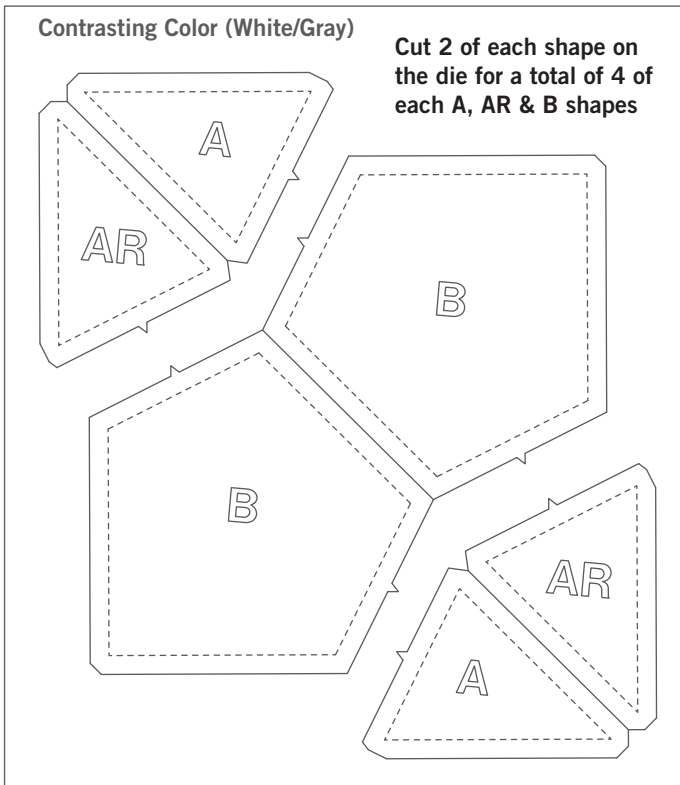
## Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 12" finished Turkey Giblets:



For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 2-color 12" finished block in one pass through the cutter.

- **Fabric Color 1:** Cut two 9½" squares or use Layer Cakes. Place right side up over shapes A, AR and B to cut four of each shape.
- **Fabric Color 2:** Cut two 9½" squares or use Layer Cakes. Place right side up over shapes A, AR and B to cut four of each shape.

### Shapes needed for 12" finished Turkey Giblets



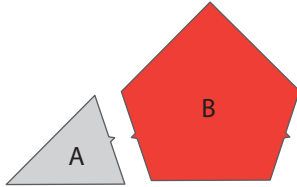

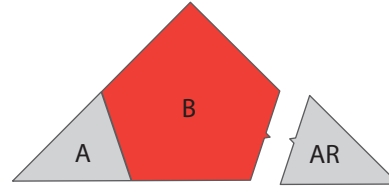
**How to Sew a 2-color Turkey GIBLETS Block:** Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed.

### Step 1



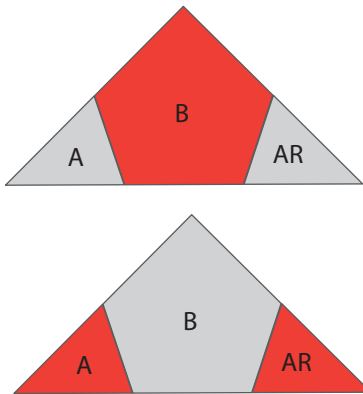
Sew Shape A to the left of contrasting Shape B using the notches for alignment. Make 4 units.

### Step 2



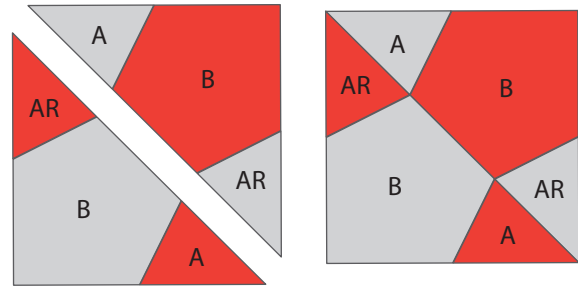
Sew Shape AR to the right of Shape B using the notches for alignment. Make 4 units.

### Step 3



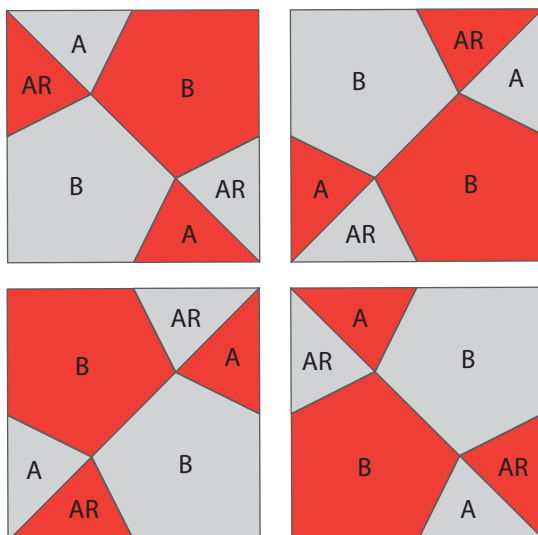
Follow steps 1-2 to make 4 more A/B/AR units in the opposite colorway.

### Step 4



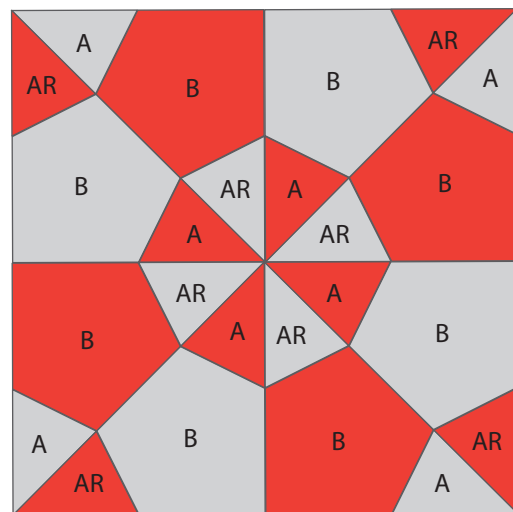
Sew contrasting A/B/AR units together from steps 1-3 to make a quarter unit as shown. Make 4 units.

### Step 5



Position and sew quarter units into rows then sew rows together to complete block.

### Step 6



Block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".
