


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
Fabric Cutting Tips for a 4-color, 11" finished Odette Block:





Shapes needed for 11" finished Odette Block


For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 4-color 11" finished block in one pass through the cutter.

- Fabric Color 1 (Red Center): Cut one 45/8" square and place right side up over shape A. Cut 1 shape.
- Fabric Color 2 (Green):
 - Cut a 3⁷/₈" strip across the width of fabric (WOF) and fan fold over shape
 B. Cut 4 shapes.
 - Cut a 37/8" strip across the WOF and fan fold over shape C. Cut 4 shapes.
 - Cut a 3¾" strip across the WOF and fan fold over shape G. Cut 4 shapes.
- Fabric Color 3 (Blue):
 - Cut a 2½" strip across the WOF and fan fold over shape D. Cut 4 shapes.
 - Cut a $2^{1}\!/\!_{8}"$ strip across the WOF and fan fold over shape E. Cut 4 shapes.
 - Cut a $2^5/8$ " strip across the WOF and fan fold over shape F with two layers right side up and two layers right side down. Cut 8 shapes.
- Fabric Color 4 (White/Background):
 - Cut a 33/4" strip across the WOF and fan fold over shape G. Cut 8 shapes.
 - Cut a 2½" strip across the WOF and fan fold over shape D. Cut 8 shapes.











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How to Sew a 4-color Odette Block: Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed.

Step 1



Sew blue shape D to shape B as shown. Make four.

Step 2



Sew B/D unit to shape A as shown to create a center block.

Step 3





Sew two white shape G to one green shape G as shown. Sew one shape F facing right and one shape F facing left to G unit as shown. Make four G/F units.

Step 4







Sew one G/F unit to opposite sides of the center block.

Step 5





Sew two white shape D to shape E as shown. Sew shape C to D/E unit as shown. Make four.

Step 6









Sew one C/D/E unit to opposite ends of one G/F unit. Make two.

Step 7



Sew the three unit rows together to complete the block as shown.

Step 8



Block should measure $11\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ ".
