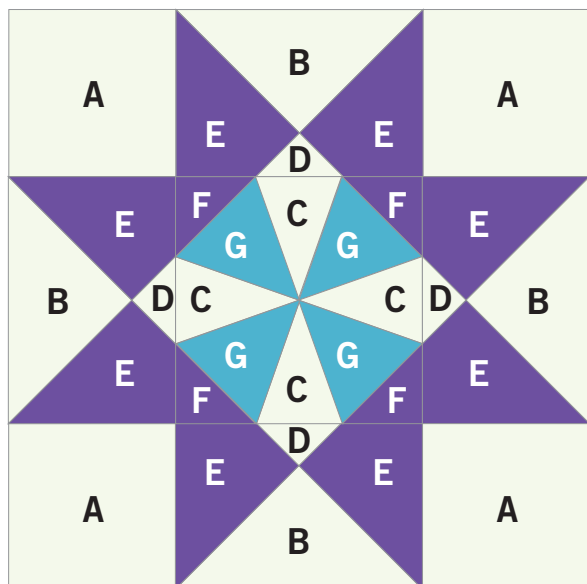




# GO!® Enigma Star-10" Finished

## Fabric Cutting Tips for a 3-color, 10" finished Enigma Star:



For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 3-color 10" finished block in one pass through the cutter.

### • Fabric Color 1 (Background):

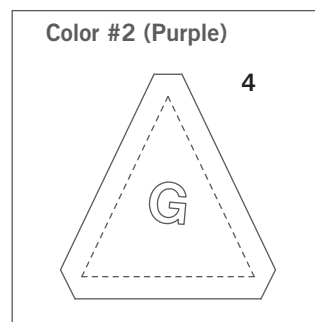
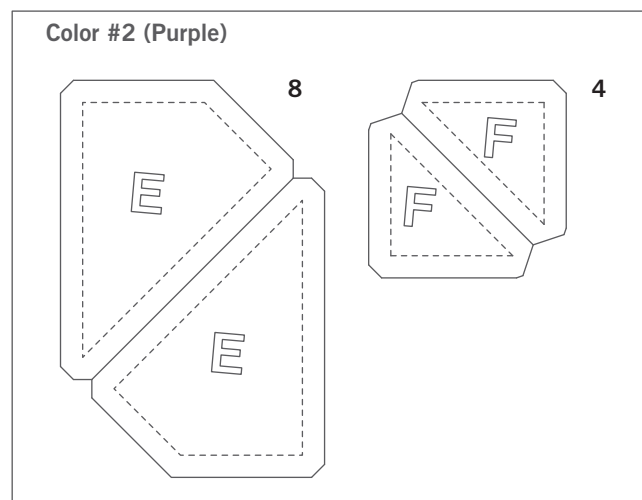
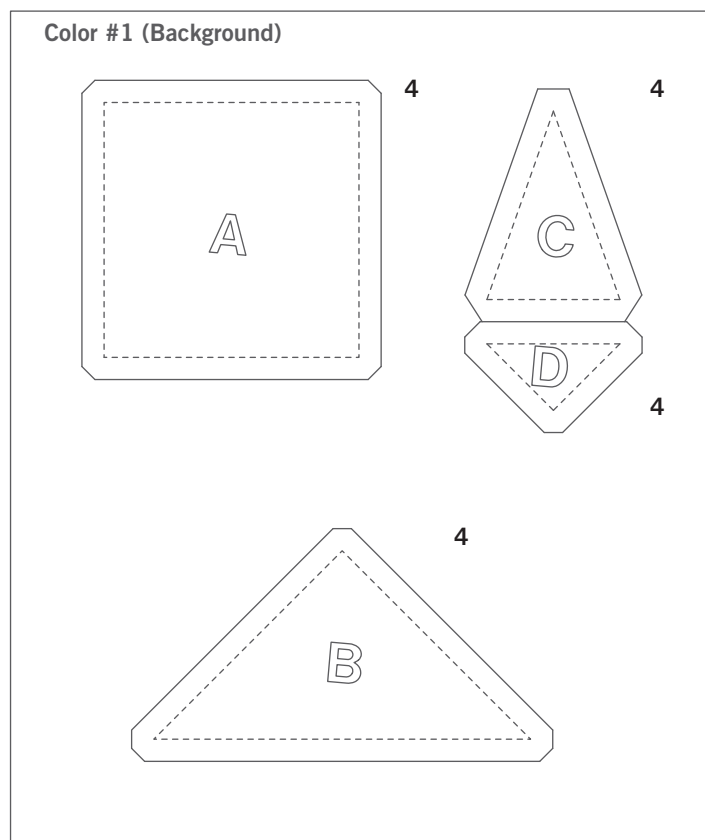
- Cut a  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " widths. Place over shape A and cut 4 shapes.
- Cut a  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " widths. Place over shape B to cut 4 shapes.
- Cut a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into  $4\frac{3}{8}$ " widths. Place over shapes C and D to cut 4 of each shape.

### • Fabric Color 2 (Purple):

- Cut four  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" rectangles. Place two rectangles right side up and two rectangles right side down over shape E to cut 8 shapes.
- Cut a  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " widths. Place over shape F to cut 4 shapes.

- **Fabric Color 3 (Blue):** Cut a  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 3" widths. Place over shape G to cut 4 shapes.

**How to Sew a 3-color Enigma Star Block:** Use a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed.

### Step 1



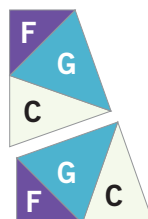
Sew shape F to shape G.  
Make four.

### Step 2



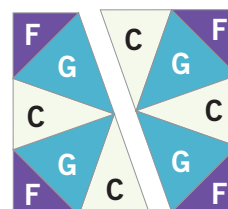
Sew one shape C to right  
side of F/G unit as shown.  
Make four.

### Step 3



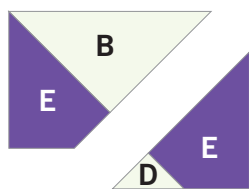
Sew two F/G/C units to-  
gether as shown to make a  
half block. Make two.

### Step 4



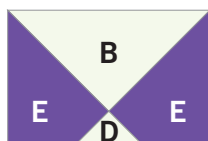
Sew two half blocks to-  
gether as shown to make a  
center block.

### Step 5



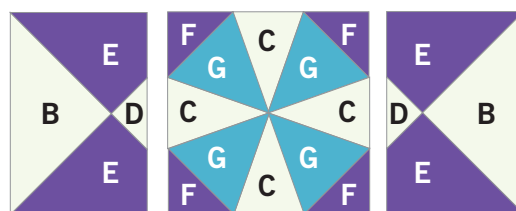
Sew shape B to longest side of shape E as  
shown. Sew shape D to shortest side of shape  
E as shown. Make four of each unit.

### Step 6



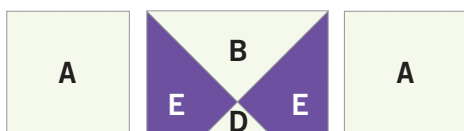
Sew B/E unit to D/E unit as  
shown. Make four.

### Step 7



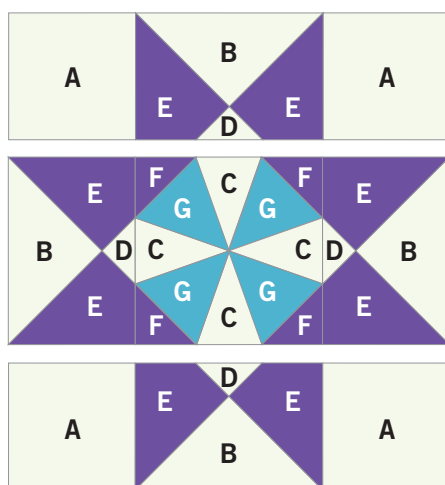
Sew one B/E/D/E unit to opposite  
ends of the center block as shown.

### Step 8



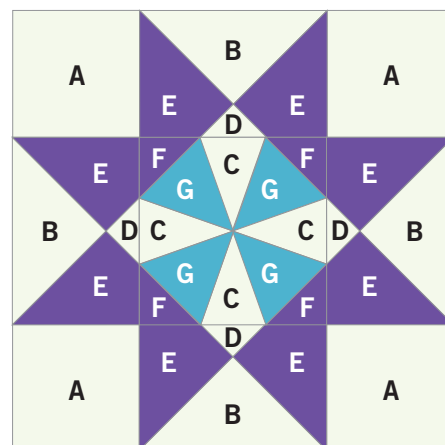
Sew one shape A to opposite ends of  
one B/E/D/E unit. Make two.

### Step 9



Sew rows together to complete  
the block.

### Step 10



Block should measure  
10½" x 10½".
