



#### Fabric Cutting Tips for a 3-color, 10" finished Enigma Star:



For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 3-color 10" finished block in one pass through the cutter.


#### • Fabric Color 1 (Background):


- Cut a  $3^7/8$ " strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into  $3^7/8$ " widths. Place over shape A and cut 4 shapes.
- Cut a  $51\!/\!4$  " strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into  $3^1\!/\!8$  " widths. Place over shape B to cut 4 shapes.
- Cut a 2½" strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 4³/s" widths. Place over shapes C and D to cut 4 of each shape.


#### • Fabric Color 2 (Purple):

- Cut four  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" rectangles. Place two rectangles right side up and two rectangles right side down over shape E to cut 8 shapes.
- Cut a 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 2<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" widths. Place over shape F to cut 4 shapes.
- Fabric Color 3 (Blue): Cut a 2<sup>7</sup>/8" strip across the width of fabric. Fanfold into 3" widths. Place over shape G to cut 4 shapes.

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How to Sew a 3-color Enigma Star Block: Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed.

#### Step 1



Sew shape F to shape G. Make four.

#### Step 2



Sew one shape C to right side of F/G unit as shown.


Make four.

#### Step 3




Sew two F/G/C units together as shown to make a half block. Make two.

Step 4




Sew two half blocks together as shown to make a center block.

Step 5




Sew shape B to longest side of shape E as shown. Sew shape D to shortest side of shape E as shown. Make four of each unit.

#### Step 6



Sew B/E unit to D/E unit as shown. Make four.

#### Step 7




Sew one B/E/D/E unit to opposite ends of the center block as shown.

#### Step 8




Sew one shape A to opposite ends of one B/E/D/E unit. Make two.

#### Step 9



Sew rows together to complete the block.

#### Step 10



Block should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".
