

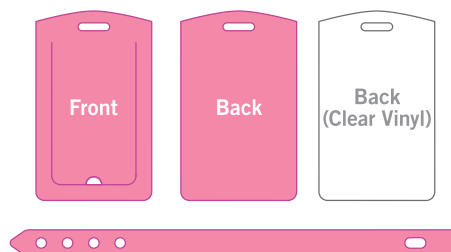


GO!® Luggage Tag

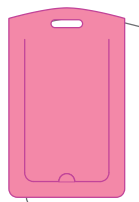
How to Assemble & Sew GO! Luggage Tag:

Step 1



Cut a 11" x 4¼" rectangle out of cork, leather or other material. Place over all shapes to cut one front, back and strap piece. Cut a 5" x 3¼" rectangle of clear vinyl or plastic. Place over the back shape and cut one.

Step 2



Align the clear vinyl back piece to the wrong side of the front piece.

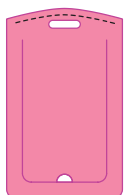


TIP Cut 2 strap pieces and sew them right sides together create a stronger, double-sided strap.

Use 100% cotton fabric to expand your options. Fuse two layers of fabric wrong sides together then cut shapes. Sew around all cut edges with desired stitch to secure layers. Then finish GO! Luggage Tag using assembly instructions.

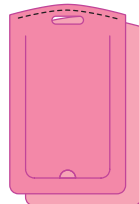
For a more durable tag, use stiffer clear plastic instead of vinyl.

Step 3



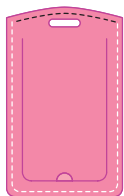
Sew close to the top curved edge to secure.

Step 4



Put back and front wrong sides together and align edges. Clear vinyl piece should be between the front and back pieces.

Step 5



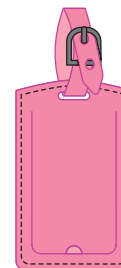
Sew close to the edge around the 2 sides and bottom to secure. Top edge should be open to insert address card.

Step 6



Making sure that the right side will be facing out, feed the prong of the buckle through the oval hole on the strap. Fold the end of the strap through and around the buckle. Sew across the strap ¼" away from the edge.

Step 7



Feed strap through tag opening and buckle.
