




GO!® Basket-6" Finished

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Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 6" finished Basket:



For best cutting results, position fabric on the lengthwise grain (straight of grain) as it goes under the roller. Tip: The die is specially designed to cut one complete 2-color 6" finished block in one pass through the cutter.



• **Fabric Color 1 (Background):**

- Cut a $5\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Place over shape A. Cut 1.
- Cut a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Place over shape B. Cut 1.
- Cut a $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $4\frac{5}{8}$ " rectangle. Place over shape C. Cut 2

• **Fabric Color 2 (Basket):**

- Cut a $5\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Place over shape A. Cut 1.
- Cut a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Place over 2 of shape D. Cut 2.
If making alternative designs, cut a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip. Fan over shape D and cut.
- Fuse and cut a $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle. Place over shape E. Cut 1.

Shapes needed for 6" finished Basket






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
How to Sew a 2-color Basket Block: Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open unless otherwise directed.

Step 1




Sew one shape D to short edge of shape C as shown. Make one facing right and one facing left.

Step 2




Sew one pink shape A to one blue shape A as shown.

Step 3




Sew right C/D unit to the left of A/A unit and left C/D unit to the bottom as shown.

Step 4




Sew shape B to C/D/A/A unit as shown.

Step 5



Center and appliqué shape E onto blue shape A as shown. Block should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".

Rearrange shapes A, B and D to create a variety of different baskets and flower designs.
