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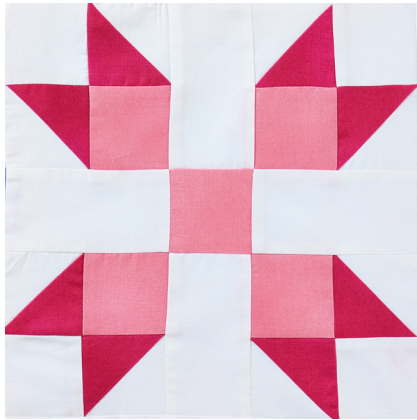

## MONTH 6: PINK BLOCKS



### FINISHED BLOCK:

10" square

### MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

- $\frac{2}{3}$  yard white print (blocks)
- $\frac{1}{3}$  yard dark pink print (blocks)
- 1—18×21" (fat quarter) piece light pink print (blocks)
- AccuQuilt GO! Qube Mix & Match 8" Block:
  - Square, 2½": Shape 2 Die (55709)
  - Half-Square Triangle, 2" Finished Square: Shape 5 Die (55712)
  - Rectangle, 2×4" Finished: Shape 8 Die (55715)

### CUT FABRICS

Cut pieces in the following order. These cutting directions use the dies found in AccuQuilt GO! Qube Mix & Match 8" Block. (Dies also are sold separately.)

#### From white print, cut:

- Subcut 2—5½"×42" strips:
  - 16 A rectangles (cut with Shape 8 Die)
  - 16 B squares (cut with Shape 2 Die)
- Subcut 16—3¾" squares:
  - 32 C triangles (cut with Shape 5 Die)

#### From dark pink print, cut:

- Subcut 16—3¾" squares:
  - 32 D triangles (cut with Shape 5 Die)

#### From light pink print, cut:

- Subcut 5—5½" squares:
  - 20 E squares (cut with Shape 2 Die)

### ASSEMBLE PINK BLOCKS

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Press seams in directions indicated by arrows on diagrams. If no direction is specified, press seam toward darker fabric.

1. Sew together a white print C triangle and a dark pink print D triangle (**Diagram 1**). Press open to make a triangle-square. The triangle-square should be 2½" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make 32 triangle-squares total.

2. Referring to **Diagram 2**, sew together one white print B square, two triangle-squares, and one light pink print E square in pairs. Join pairs to make a corner unit. The unit should be 4½" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make 16 corner units total.

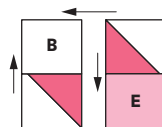

3. Referring to **Diagram 3**, lay out four corner units, four white print A rectangles, and one light pink print E square in three rows. Sew together pieces in rows. Join rows to make a pink block. The block should be 10½" square including seam allowances. Repeat to make four pink blocks total. Set blocks aside.

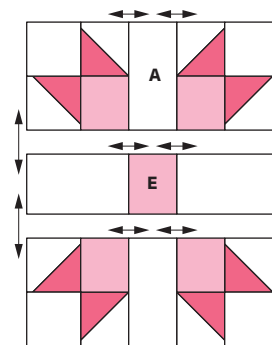
