T-Shirt Transformation Ruler Instructions

Center, mark and cut perfect t-shirt sections for quilt blocks, tote bags and pillows.

- Cut t-shirt at sides and remove the sleeves and neck line.
- 2. Pre-determine what the finished size of your block will be; either 10", 12" or 15" square or a combination of these dimensions to form a rectangle.
- 3. Cut fusible interfacing at least 1" larger than your finished block size determined in the previous step. Following the manufacturer's instructions, apply the interfacing to the back of the t-shirt, centering it behind the design. NOTE: Cover t-shirt design with a pressing cloth prior to fusing the interfacing to prevent damage to the t-shirt design or iron.
- 4. Using markings on the ruler, center ruler on t-shirt design. For 15 ½" dimension, mark or rotary cut on outside edges of ruler. For 12 ½" or 10 ½" dimensions, mark in corresponding slots, then slide ruler to markings and rotary cut.
- 5. Use finished t-shirt blocks as desired to create your one-of-a-kind t-shirt guilt or project.

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
