DIRECTIONS

Helpful Hint: Tilt rotary cutter blade at a slight angle when placing into teardrop shape for easy insertion.

To Cut Strips:

- 1. Fold fabric selvage to selvage.
- Lay Shape Cut[™] Pro on fabric with raw edges extending slightly beyond vertical slot marked "0" and bottom fold of fabric at horizontal line marked "0".
- 3. Square up left edge of fabric by inserting blade of cutter in slot marked "0" and cut.
- 4. Cut subsequent strips to desired widths.

To Create Jelly Rolls:

- Fold fabrics selvage to selvage. Layer up to 4 different fabrics.
- 2. Square up fabric and cut strips per instructions for cutting 2-1/2" strips.
- Lift ruler and stack desired number of strip sets on top of each other, aligning folds and raw side edges.
- 4. Beginning with selvage edges, roll strip stack to create "Jelly Roll".

TIP: For best results, lift stack of strips off work surface and allow to hang off edge of table once the roll has been started.

To Cut Squares:

- 1. Cut strips to desired width following previous instructions.
- Keeping cut strips intact, lift Shape Cut[™] Pro and turn 90°. Make sure fabric extends beyond vertical 0 and 20 slots and is aligned with bottom "0" marking.
- 3. Cut desired width in opposite direction.
